Course N.W. by E
Late Watch the same

Wednesday 22. Wind N.W. by E
Spoke. Boat came prebel of Lyn
Capt Landfield he being anxious
in to the Gauthier's planer
for water & provisions & had not but
little water. Made up my mind
to go in with him

Course N.W. by E at 2 P.M. saw the land
at 5 P.M. by with the mouth of the harbor
at 8th Ene came to anchor in off shore lane
in 5 fathoms of water in company
with Prebel

Middle and Late employed in getting of
water here & fine light N.W.
and quit sleep from home
So Ene lying in off shore lane

Remarks Tuesday 25
Fine winds from S.W. at 6 A.M.
got got under way stood out of
the bay at 12 all clear Light breeze
So Ene

Remarks Wednesday 29
Light breeze from N.E. sharp up employed
in sending up Royal West House
sent up fore & gailent mast and yards
bent the gail at Fort Calves

Middle & Late Light breeze from
S.E. thick and foggy Course N.W. by E
Sent up Mizzen top gailent mast and sent

Remarks Thursday 30
Fine breeze from S.E. Course N.W. by E
bent the old jib for a Main top mast
Staysail
