Sunday April 10th A. D. 1853

First part fine breeze

from K. K. H. and overcast hazy weather starting E. ward for the
Isle of Palau hmo the land being in sight since then a bark in sight
starting with us and 3 P.M. entered the Bay and at 7 o'clock came to
and anchored in 15 fathoms water the Capt. of the Port came on board

Monday April 11th 1853

first breeze picked up the Boats all hands engaged in getting off a
raft of water and washing the Ships & several Stoves & Cookstoves
Ships & Coasters the Bark Friends put back and came to
rescued the company of three ^{off the shore} ~~spawners~~ from the shore

Tuesday April 12th 1853

This day commences fine weather.

and fresh breeze down to Bay all hands engaged in painting ship getting
Mr. Wood and Antton 3 men got sloops ashore after water.
Sailed ship Will. Proctor Jr. 14 and bark Wm. & Lewis & S.

This closer with strong breeze we obliged to leave the raft
of water all hands on board with the exceptions of 11 Capt and
3 men who were intoxicated

while lazily at Anacapa in Islas Llanas Chili Apr.

Wednesday April 13th A.D. 1858

weather and fresh breeze the Star. Watch on Liberty
those on board engaged in painting ship ^{be} got of our water
and Discharged the Cruisers 11 in all Tailed Bank. P. once
this day Ends the watch on shore

Thursday April 14th 1853

This day fine weather

and by so doing the Span^l watch on Liberty those on board
engaged in painting the bands of Whigs sailed ship Franklin
and 2 others this day Ends with the watch on shore

Friday April 18th 1880

The Bay and fine weather the U.S. watch on Lechitz took
on board engaged in sowing water in main hatch way
old Schooner Victory from Puget Sound bound to
California and English bark arrived also E.
the Blacksmith Daniel Brown Deserted to Endeavour this day

Saturday April 16th 1853

This Day fine weather the Gar.

work on boats, those on board employ in ship. sails
getting ready for sea. Hazel a Native of Hazel Point
this day closes the winter season for the herds.

Sunday April 17th 1858

This day I will write

from. Got the all hands on board the ship ready for sea
waiting for men & sail in the Offing so End this day
