 Comm with strong breeze from the NNE at 2.00. commenced cutting to rough to save the head of. lost one of the blubber floes at 2.00. lashed down for the right moderate breeze through the right a heavy swell on at 4.00 Comm cutting at 6. finished the fore ship made sail to the northward at 7. commenced boiling at 10.00 saw whales lowered chased going to fast so ends. Lat N 41. 55
 Tuesday
 Jan 22
 Comm with strong breeze from the NNE saw several whales going to fast to lower at 5.00 took in the jib & spanker at 7 took in the topsails & wore ship strong breeze through the right latter part so. Lat N 41. 59
 Wednesday
 Jan 23
 Comm with strong breeze from S.W. employed boiling at 1.00 wore ship side part light airs and calm at 1.00 finished boiling latter employed in breaking out the fore hold and stowing down at 9.00 saw whales lowered going to fast at 11.00 saw more lowered chased to no purpose so ends. Lat N 41. 56
 Thursday
 Jan 24
 Comm with light breeze from the E.S.E. steering S.W. employed in stowing down at 5.00 saw whales lowered to no purpose at 7 took in sail light airs and calm through the right daylight made sail at 8.00 saw whales lowered lowered chased going to fast at 10 saw more lowered chased going to fast saw 4 ships in sight. Lat N 41. 57
 Friday
 Jan 25
 Comm with light airs from the S.E. at 2.00 saw whale lowered chased going quick at 4.00 tracked to the westward at 6.00 spoke the ship Neptune of New London Capt. 12.00. side part strong breeze at 1.00 the Neptune wore round and run in to us struck abreast of the fore chains and carried away channels & at down the plank shear and stove the two barboard boats lost one line two sets of oars and the draft carried away the mizen topsail & Belpay split the fore spencer fore part one got clear & tried the pumps.

 and found that she made no water the Neptune lost her mastsprit and one boat at a close reefed the main topsail all hands employed in repairing damages at 4.00 boarded back away the jib and mizzen & latter part employed in fitting the plankshire fore channels and setting up the fore rigging & at 11.00 set the fore topsail. Close reefed so ends strong breeze 150 lbs.

 Jan 26
 Comm with strong breeze from the NNE employed in fitting the fore channels & rigging at 1.00. Bent a new fore sail and sent down the mizen topsail gave middle part light breeze at daylight made sail & employed in fitting the boat at 3.00 saw whales and lowered two boats and got fast line parted lost two men returned on board so ends light airs & calm
 Tuesday
 Jan 27
 Comm with light airs from the E.S.E. employed in fitting davies mizen topsail yard & at 3.00 lowered for whales got fast and killed one at 6 took him alongside at 7. Comm cutting out in the head throat and lips at 10. lashed down for the right light breeze through the right at 11.00 hooked on at 7. finished saw whales lowered going quick to westward latter part strong breeze
 Wednesday
 Jan 28
 Comm with strong gales from the North employed boiling at 1.00 light breeze from the S.W. and mizzen & lashed down the works at 6.00. Cleared up saw whales lowered going to fast at 8. began to boil light breeze through the right at 1.00 made sail at saw whales lowered going to fast at 9.00 saw more lowered got fast & killed one so ends with light breeze. Lat N 42. 32
 Thursday
 Jan 29
 Comm with breeze at 2.00 took the whale at 3.00. Comm cutting at 7. finished & took in sail & Comm boiling strong breeze through the right latter part so. employed in starting new fore line & floor
 Friday
 Jan 30
 Comm with strong breeze from S.W. employed in stowing down the after hold & boiling strong breeze through the right at 7.00 set the fore topsail & spanker & wore ship at 9. saw whales lowered got fast & from over so ends three ships in sight. No. 10
