Saturday Come with strong breeze from the South
March employed in moiling & flagging lash at 5 PM
the finished moiling moderate breeze through the
28 night at 5 AM made sail & employed in breaking
out the main hatchway & stowing down
so ends No Ob.

Sunday Come with light breeze from W & S W
March employed in stowing down at 4 sounded 5
the gullions strong breeze through the night & S W
29 W standing to the SE at 11 double reefed the
topsails & took in the jib at 6 AM made sail
and stowed S & S W three men down with the hawser
at 9 AM spoke the Herald of Fairhaven 1300
R. Anne of Bristol 1000 so ends strong
breeze from W & S W

Thursday Come with light breeze from S & S E
April at 1 AM tacked to the S W at 6 set the top
the mast the topgallant studensails wind & N by S steering
2 S by W middle part light breeze from S & S E
& thick at 4 AM set the fore studensail & fore top
gallant studensail at 11 took in the studensail
& hurried up wind S & S E so ends Lat N 41:15

the masts & flying jib down out & middle part calm
3 at 2 light breeze from S & S W at 4 foggy at 7
set the studensails & steered South at 8 AM sent up
the Royal yards so ends light breeze. No Ob.

April steering South & thick employed in making rigging
the & 2 knotting gains at 7 AM took in the Royal & fore
4 gallant studensails middle part strong breeze from
W by N at 3 AM took in the topmast studensail
at 9 took in the top gallant sail so ends strong
breeze from W & S W Lat N 39:40
