Tuesday April the 21: 1829
Comm with brisk breeze from SE & squally
Employed in beating up the Bay at 2 passed the fort &
shortened sail at 3 came to in 3 fathoms water & furled
the sails light breeze through the night & shower at 6 comm
filling weather & hogging at 11 finished the Larkwood side
so ends Reiny

Wednesday April the 22 1829
Comm with light breeze & Reiny Employed in
hogging the Starboard side & scraping at 11 finished strong
breeze through the night from the Westward at 6 part
of the crew on liberty & employed in blacking the Buns
&

Thursday April the 23: 1829
Comm with light breeze from SE Employed
in sundry jobs strong breeze through the night from
SE at 9 part of the crew on liberty & employed in
filling the blackbays & so ends

Friday April the 24 1829
Comm with light breeze from SE & shower
Employed in sundry jobs light breeze through the
night at 6 sent a boat on shore for water at 10
returned & one boat after oranges so ends

Saturday April the 25: 1829
Comm with light breeze from SE Employed
in blacking the Buns & painting the stern light
breeze through the night at 6 comm filling water &
blackening the Buns & one boat after oranges

Sunday April the 26: 1829
Comm with light airs from SE Employed in
sundry jobs light airs through the night Larkwood part
Employed in breaking out provisions & stowing
off

Monday April the 27: 1829
Comm with light airs from SE at 1. Breeze short
at 3 part of the crew on liberty light airs & calm
at 6 got underway light airs from SE at 8 AM passed
the fort at 11 calm so ends
