Friday January 16th / 67

Commenced with a moderate breeze from the S. all sail set - steering S. E. employed in ship's duty middle and latter part much like the fore part

Saturday January 17th / 67

Commenced with a moderate breeze from the S. E. all sail set - employed in ship's duty out between deck & steering in back - middle & latter part much like the fore part - Latitude 34.36 N Barometer 30.9 1/2

Sunday January 18th / 67

Commenced lighter at sail - steering S. E. all sail set - wind from S. E. at 4 o'clock - changed about 2 1/2 a half hour for a Sulphur bottom - changed about 2 1/2 a half hour - latter part calm

Monday January 19th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from the S. employed in ship's duty - steering in back - middle & latter part much like the fore part - Latitude 34.91 N

Tuesday January 20th / 67

Commenced lighter - steering S. E. middle part much like the fore part - at 12 o'clock - landed a boat & boarded an American Bark (first letter on board from the S. E. to S. E. 101 to 34) - Alliance 71 days from Boston

the 23rd of December. Departed spoken the Bark & stopped at Cape Cod - 2 o'clock - Longitude 25.11 W middle & latter part much like the fore part

Commenced lighter - from the S. E. all sail set - steering S. E. & S. E. 1/2 S middle part latter part steering S. E. wind - heading to the S. E. - from the S. E. - Latitude 34.06 N

Thursday January 23rd / 67

Commenced lighter - with variable winds on different tacks - two sails in sight - heading to the S. E. employed in ship's duty - latter part the fore part - steering middle part - latter part moderate - Latitude 34.59 N Longitude 25.31 W

Barometer 30.1 1/2 Friday January 24th / 67

Commenced moderate from the S. E. all sail set - employed in ship's duty on different tacks - latter part - on different tacks - wind from the Eastward - Latitude 34.20 North

Commenced moderate from the S. E. heading to the S. E. & S. E. wind about E. employed in ship's duty - steering up the jib - Latitude 34.20 North

Commenced strong from the S. E. all sail set - steering S. E. & S. E. at 3 o'clock - took in all the light sails - one sail in sight - middle & latter part steering S. E. - latter part strong - Latitude 34.04 N

Commenced strong from the Eastward steering S. E. fore part - all the light sails in - employed in ship's duty - middle & latter part fresh breeze all sail set - steering S. E. & S. E. 1/2 S - Latitude 23.52 N

Tuesday January 28th / 67

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the S. E. all sail set - steering S. E. & S. E. 1/2 S - Bent Mizzen top-sails & main top-sails - steering S. E. - middle & latter part much like the fore part
