 heading S.W. Employed in ship duty middle
 & latter part much like the fore part Lat S
 Longitude W

Commenced moderate from the S.E. all
 sail set heading to the S.W. Latter part
 fresh steering to the wind Lat S
 Longitude W

Celia (My Wife) Birth day 20 years of age.

Commenced fresh from the S.E. steering to
 the wind heading from S.W. to S.W. by S
 employed in ship duty
 at 1 P.M. opened a box My Dear Wife gave me
 the morning's gift home as a present on
 her birth day. It caused my mind to wander
 way back to her. To the one which has made
 those solemn vows & I have faith to believe
 she will fulfill them. Celia you have my best
 wishes & hope to night you are happy in the
 Lord. Doubtless to night you will think
 of me & speak about the boy. He is now
 two months & three days from home. & oh how
 I long for a letter from you. Celia, boy is a
 consolation to me to know I have written

 heading to the S.W.

Sunday March 1st 1868

Commenced moderate from the S.E.
 veering from S.E. to S.W. by S heading
 to the S.W. all sail set. middle & latter part
 much like the fore part Latitude S
 Longitude W

Monday March 2nd 1868

29.3 1/10

Commenced light from the S.E. all sail set. middle
 & latter part much like the fore part. At 4 P.M.
 towing toward the boat & fractured the cable
 it being the first time that some of them ever
 pulled an ear. & they was bent as much as
 awkward as you generally see men & can't under-
 stand any English. Latter part moderate breeze
 from S.E. Latitude S
 Longitude W

Tuesday March 3rd

Commenced moderate from the S.E. all sail
 set. employed in receiving cargo to the
 fore rigging. Latter part much like the
 fore part Latitude South
 Longitude West

Wednesday March 4th 1868

Ten weeks from N. S. Cape

Commenced fresh from the S.E. heading
 about S.W. all sail set. employed in
 ship duty. Latitude S
 Longitude

Commenced strong from the S.E. heading
 to the S.W. look in for legalantail. employed
 in ship duty. Latter part more moderate. all
 sail set. Latitude S. Longitude West

Friday Mar 6th 1868

Commenced fresh, all sail set steering to the
 wind. at daylight raised the Island of Trinidad
 & the Islands to the windward Latitude S
 Longitude W
