H. at 7.40 in. made sail at 12.30. was shot & shot to
by 4.0. died in close to the first round at 5.00.
Ankered sail.

Monday June 8th / 68

Splended { Commenced real moderate. all sail set trying to
weather work to the windward. to the S.W. on different tracks
in sight of the land. nothing in sight worth
of notice. Blowing no waves to night.

Tuesday June 9th / 68

Eight } commenced light from the W.S.W. on different
 & } tacks. land in sight. all sail in use, at night-
 nearly } shortened sail. boats on the lower crains, the
 cabin } for the first time they have been there for many a
 Boats on } day. the weather is beautiful but not a whisper
 the lower } in sight. nor a s p o yet
 (great crain)

Wednesday June 10th / 68

24 Weeks from here promised to love & cherish
commenced with fine weather. Northeast gale
of snow but no wind with the exception of
Ginlocks. Working ship to the NW
standing sea halcyon to night. No land in sight
wind abate. NW

Thursday June 11th

Moderate from the NW working to the SE
at 5 PM Shortened sail, no land in sight.

Friday June 12th / 68

fine weather any how. That is what ^{is} the matter

Saturday Aug 13th / 68

Commenced procedure, middle part

Friday June 12. 18

Commenced moderate at 10 till she lowered sail
at 12 under a close reefed mainstaysail wind from

Saturday June 13th
