Wednesday August 12th / 68
Commenced fresh & rainy. Wind from the W
& continued so. of 9 on all day. No observation
Thirty Three Weeks from Sweetnes. Latitude 26 09 S
Longitude 175 47 W

Thursday August 13th / 68
Commenced from the W & S heading to the
N & W for part at 12th was ship & took to in
Sd. Showers. middle part moderate & uncloudy
Latitude 25 50 Longitude 175 49 W

Friday August 14th / 68
Commenced moderate. Main topgallant sail set. & it
raised a sail on the weather beam under double
reefed topsails. about 2.30 P.M. spoke the Bark
of Hoper Town. N. S. W. 30 bars
barrel of sperm four months out on different
tacks during the day. Wind from the W & W
Lat 26 04 S Long 175 47 W

Saturday August 15th / 68
Strong from the W & W equally employed
in ship duty. That is all I have got to say for
this day Lat 26 02 S Long 175 50 W

Sunday August 16th / 68
Strong breeze from the W & W. of the wind used
double reefed topsails & foresail. squally Lat 25 52 S
Long 175 45 W

Monday August 17th / 68
Commenced strong from the W. on different
tacks. employed overhauling the blocks
nothing worthy of notice to day Lat 25 49 S
Long 175 38 W

Tuesday August 18th / 68
Commenced strong from the S & W. of the
employed in ship duty. at 8 P.M. wind
hauled to the E. Latitude 25 50 S
Longitude 175 45 W

Cruising of Masques Aug 1868

Wednesday August 19th / 68
Thirty Four Weeks from N little duck.
Commenced fresh from the Eastward. Employed
in ship duty. steering to the W & W. at 6 P.M.
Spoke the Bark Northern Light - 650 blb
of oil - mostly whale oil. Latitude 25 45 South
Longitude 176 01 West

Thursday August 20th / 68
Commenced light & continued so all through
these twenty four hours. Two sail sight. Head sailing
to the S & S. Lat 25 25 S Long 175 12 W

Friday August 21st / 68
for part moderate from the S & E. all
sail set. working to the S & E. Latter part
strong from the N. heading of the wind
employed in dog baking out water from the ground
tier. & filling with salt. Lat 25 10 S Long 175 12 W

Saturday August 22nd / 68
Commenced strong from the S. of the wind
on the main tack. at 6.30 A.M. two sail reefed
topsails. at 7 both in foretopsail. at 10th made
sail. wind moderated. heading to the S & W
wind from the S & W. Northern Light in sight

Sunday August 23rd / 68
Commenced fresh from the S & W. steering to
the E. during the day. nothing worthy of
notice. Latitude 24 44 S Long 172 21 W

Monday August 24th / 68
Commenced fresh steering to the Eastward
about 1 P.M. the Northern Light boreed after
sperm whale, & struck. they struck two whales
and turned them up. The lowerd about 3 P.M.
and chased until dark. The whale was
shot. We took one of the Northern Lights
& cut it & build it for half
