

Remarks on board Bark Albion

Saturday October 16th /68

Commenced very light, employed coping the fore rigging. Tamed with the Abraham Barker another sail in sight to the N. of W. Middle & latter part much like the fore part. Lat

Sunday October 17th /68

Commenced light & continued so all three tugs four have about 600 gained with the Abraham Barker. Lat

S. Longitude

Monday October 18th /68

Commenced very light, employed in ship duty three sails in sight, Abraham Barker, Northern Light Ship Bar. Greenold, steering to the S. & W. latter part moderate. Lat 25 18 S. Long 174 48 W

Tuesday October 20th /68

Commenced strong with rain from the N. & W. middle & latter part wind from S. & E. saw the Bar Greenold. Latitude

Wednesday October 21st /68

43 miles from the Commenced strong from the S. & W. and continued so all three tugs four have gained with the Bar Greenold 600 since leaving the bay of islands. Lat

Thursday October 22nd /68

Commenced with a good breeze, steering to the S. & W. at night shortened sail, employed in ship duty, starboard watch setting up Main & Mizzen rigging. Lat 25 15 S

Long 175 39 W

Friday October 23rd /68

fresh breeze from the S. & E. about 6 30 A.M. raised sperm whale John Howl & John Bernard lower all four boats. Starboard boat struck & killed a blackboard boat struck just as he was going in his fluke. Saw very few birds.

sailing on Casagosa Sen. month out 200 barrels

Friday October 23rd /68

Sperm whale. Took him along side about 12 M. commenced to cut, finished about 2 30 P.M. set the watch. Starboard watch having the first watch over. Lat 26 15 S. Longitude 176 W

Saturday October 24th /68

Fresh breeze from the S. & E. wind, all hands on deck. Employed sailing to whale head, winds blew twenty four hours. Latitude 26 S. Longitude 176 11 W

Sunday October 25th /68

Months from. Who? Who do you support? Saw S. & E. Breeze fresh from the S. & E. Employed in sailing. Built under short sail. Standing watch & watch. Lat 25 59 S. Longitude 176 11 W

Monday October 26th /68

Commenced strong from the Eastward heading to starboard & latter part middle part steering to the S. & E.

Tuesday October 27th /68

Commenced strong from the S. & E. with rain middle & latter part much the same. Lat

Wednesday October 28th /68

43 miles from. Commenced strong from the S. & E. employed steering down wind. At 9 30 P.M. made a little sail. Latter part moderate. Lat

S. Long

Thursday October 29th /68

Commenced fresh from the S. & E. steering to the S. & W. The cooper employed setting up cask. Lat

S. Long

Friday October 30th /68

Commenced strong from the S. & E. all sail set steering to the S. & W. employed in ship duty. Middle & latter part much the same. Latitude 26 16 S. Longitude 176 18 W
