Thursday January 4th 1869

Commenced strong from the S. W. under the
 sail for part middle part made about all sail
 at 2 P.M. sent the speaker down repaired in the
 tent is again

Friday January 5th 1869

Commenced fresh from the S. W. part
 strong at 6 P.M. left in Main sail & full sail
 from the S. W. in sight of the land

Saturday January 6th 1869

Commenced strong middle part fresh all
 at 4 P.M. the wind from the W. veering
 several points during the day. Bark Uthellon in
 sight called part strong

Sunday January 7th 1869

For part strong middle part moderate. Made
 in for Pitts Strait at 6 P.M. calm & a heavy sea
 running toward the boat & landed until 11.30 P.M.
 tired of the calm & best of the sail & the
 then had a light & air

Monday January 8th 1869

Light wind from the S. W. Ed. King & Pitt in
 the boat on shore cut sitting wood & and the other
 one getting meat & potatoes left then just dark
 sent Lucia at 11.22

Tuesday January 9th 1869

Commenced light from the S. W. at 5.30
 toward a few black fish. Starboard bear struck
 & got it at 10.30 P.M. arrived with the Bark
 Uthellon. Middle and full part light

Wednesday January 10th 1869

Commenced light from the S. W. by the wind
 middle part standing to the S. W. E. called part
 heading in the shore

55 Weeks from the crew I think of a after. When
 I could only see her to night. If it was only possible
 to see the day come when I shall meet her in the native land

Cruising of Chatham Islands January 1869

Thursday January 14th 1869

Commenced light from the S. W. at 11.30. Land in
 sight & one sail. Very heavy sea for a short distance

Friday January 15th 1869

Commenced moderate & continued so all day steering
 to the S. W. at 4 P.M. sent down the M. and full sail
 another one at 7. Toward all from boat after some
 sort of shooting fish. Called them blackfish when we heard
 but did not see them again

Saturday January 16th 1869

Commenced moderate from the S. W. Ed. steering
 S. W. at 4 P.M. up to the wind heading to the S. W.

Sunday January 17th 1869

Light breeze from the S. W. & heading to the S. W. & E.

Monday January 18th 1869

Commenced moderate from the S. W. Ed. steering
 to the S. W. & E. foggy most of the day

Tuesday January 19th 1869

Commenced light from the S. W. steering to the
 S. W. & E. thick and hazy most of the time

6 Weeks from Wednesday January 21st 1869

Home Commenced light from the S. W. steering to the S. W. & E.
 at 11.30 sent Lucia at 6 P.M. toward Pitts Island

Thursday January 21st 1869

Strong from the S. W. & employed repairing the
 the fish. No sail in sight

Friday January 22nd 1869

Moderate gale of wind from the S. W. & E.
 on different sails at 9 P.M. sent the fore-
 top sail
