

Sunday July 18th 1869

Commenced strong at 8 AM heavy squall from the S.W. after the M.T. galantail shortened sail middle part strong

Monday July 19th

light breeze from the S.W. employed mending M.T. galantail then sent down the mainsail & repairing

Tuesday July 20th 1869

Commenced fine breeze from the S.W. & all sail set steering to the S.W. & employed repairing the mainsail sail at night shortened sail & stood boat crew

Wednesday July 21st

fine breeze from the S.W. steering to the S.W. Sweet ship breeze the mainsail & sent in the job & repaired it at 4 PM

Thursday July 22nd 1869

Weather squally with a little rain repaired the sails & going to

Friday July 23rd 1869

Fresh breeze from the S.W. In the act of setting the foretopsail carried in away at the double & set the close reef in latter part strong at 2 PM repaid the mainsail

Saturday July 24th 1869

Strong all through tiller twenty four hours repaired the main topsail

Sunday July 25th

James Murray fresh breeze from the S.W. steering to the S.W. & armed with the James Murray eleven months out 700 lbs

Monday July 26th

fresh breeze from the S.W. steering to the S.W. & employed in ship duty

Tuesday July 27th

Fine weather all tiller twenty four hours employed making out provisions & confining them on sail in light wind from the S.W. steering to the S.W. latter part steering to the S.W.

Wednesday July 28th 1869

Fine weather steering to the S.W. latter part rain

Thursday July 29th

moderate breeze from the S.W. steering W.S.W. rainy all the fore part & strong middle part

Friday July 30th 1869

Fore part nearly calm and very rough sea all in shape at 10 AM commenced to breeze at 12 PM took in foretopsail latter part moderate gale of wind with rain

Saturday July 31st 1869

moderate gale of wind all of tiller twenty four hours with frequent showers of rain

Sunday July August 1st 1869

Fresh breeze all day fore part under short sail at 10 PM made a little sail

Monday August 2nd

Commenced moderate from the S.W. about 9 AM from Starboard raised a white water about 11.30 raised the whole, spars, three boats & chased until dark the whole working to the windward
