

Lying at anchor at Feeje Island

Monday August 16th / 69

fish breeze blowing to the N.W. a - delight - rain
one of the Feeje Indians came to anchor about 2
o'clock in company with the other ships from Suva
& Francis Mura.

Tuesday Aug 17

Fine weather. Employed in painting & ship
digressed up all the black paint in the ship.

46 Weeks

Wednesday Aug 18

from M. Fine weather all day. Employed getting water
from the M. from Park outside (if I remember right)

Thursday August 19th

Light breeze. Getting water from Park & can
to anchor to day

Friday August 20th

Fine weather. Sent two boats up after jam
The rest employed in ship duty

Saturday August 21st / 69

Thick haze & rain. The boats arrived back about
9 AM with jam

Sunday Aug 22nd / 69

Strong breeze from the E.

Monday Aug 23rd

Strong breeze from the S.W. Employed getting
of wood & water.

Tuesday Aug 24th / 69

Commenced strong from the S & E
Employed getting of wood

47 Weeks from my home

20 months from home Wednesday August 25th

Strong trade. getting of wood & getting the
ship ready for sea.

Feeje Island Aug 29th / 69

Thursday August 26th / 69

Commenced strong from the S & E. Ship all
ready for sea. Employed overhauling blocks.

Friday August 27th / 69

Strong trade. Employed in ship duty. Ship all
ready for sea. Took in topail shot, ashore & coal tank
them.

Saturday August 28th / 69

for part strong trade. middle part rather
lighter. Ship all ready for sea. went on shore to
day & got two barrels of sand

Sunday August 29th

Commenced good trade. at 6 AM here up the
starboard anchor. At 10 AM went on board
of the Park from Francis Mura to meeting as a
M. Shionas came down to speak to us. came
from meeting. I at 1 PM here up and went
to sea. got out clear of the reef about 1 PM
latter part strong breeze. all the light sails
in. The obtained four men. about 20
hags or pigs I should call the most of them.
about one 1000 jars some brown & some
= nuts & a few sweet potatoes. We left these
sails at anchor. We went in on the
weather side. and as the trade blew stronger
in. I if they are strong in is useless to attempt
to get over. after we got out - we all
rejoiced to think we were once more upon
the water again. although I do not
approve leaving port upon the Sabbath day

Monday Aug 30th / 69

Strong breeze from the S.W. by Middle & latter
part wind from the S & E leading to the
S. I added the anchors & stowed the chains
