

Remarks on board Bark Albion

Saturday January 14th / 70

Commenced with a moderate breeze from
some southerly & ended somewhere. Thick
fog at 3 PM raised the Spruce, run down from
in wind from the S.W.

Sunday January 16th / 70

Commenced light. Middle part the sarge
part fish. Sailed with the Bark Orion

Monday January 17th / 70

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the
latter part it hailed to the S.W. During the
middle part hails in for ship and also the
main latter part more moderate, made a
little sail heading to the S.W. Two sails in
sight & the S. and bearing to the S.W.

Tuesday January 18th / 70

Commenced with fresh from the S.W. an even
fresh most of the day & two sails sight

Wednesday January 19th / 70

Commenced strong. Took a topsail for a
few miles the main topsail with an arrow
of rain, wind hauling from the S.W. to the
land blowed quite fresh, heading to the S.W.
latter part more moderate. Wind hauled
to the westward of S.W.

Thursday January 20th / 70

Commenced strong from the S.W. as day
as a close reefed topsail, steering N.E. & at
4 P.M. made the land ahead. The Bark Orion
started to go in at 5 PM raised another sail
to the S.W.

Friday January 21st / 70

Commenced moderate. Latter part strong
the S.W. one sail in sight

Saturday January 22nd / 70

fore part strong from the S.W. Middle and
latter part moderate. Sailed with Bark
Oregon & Minnesota

Sunday January 23rd / 70

Commenced moderate from the S.W. Middle and
latter part strong from the S.W. Two sails in sight
at 7.45 P.M. one ship standing to the S.W. Spruce bearing
to the S.W. about 10 miles or there about. Haul with
was on my passage home to my native land that is
nothing to encourage you to stay on board of this ship
I hope & pray the day may come when one may see he
is in the wrong and causing a great injury to another
one. I may have worked & caused around your whole
if our men thought so why did he not go so long ago
and then I should have been different in regard to his
whole I will run as much risk as the most of
men, have I been up and of sixteen years at sea and
learned nothing in whaling I should think so to
have some talk. Although I will not take the accused
cup although more than you wrong. It shall not be
seen that I turned out to be a drunkard. I have
got more strength of mind than all that. I have
not written much of late to you & your because
I expect to join you before the close of this year

Monday January 24th / 70

Commenced strong from the S.W. at 6 P.M. kept
running for S.W. & S.W. Between the point of view & light
hoisted and hoisted
