Monday May 30th / 70

Commenced heavy rain the S.W. heading about 8 A.M. at 9 A.M. W. at 8 P.M. the crew about 9 took in jib at 11 the main & foretopmast shaly after broke out a cask of rum from between decks at 3 P.M. sent a man to at 5 M. a star sight of foretopmast. Slicing the wind about S. or S.W.

Tuesday May 31st / 70

Commenced moderate from the S. heading the S.W. all sail set. sometimes heading on the S.W. latter part lighter air.

Wednesday June 1st / 70

Commenced calm middle part moderate from the S.W. smooth sea. Retained the M. M. slight. Latter part light.

Thursday June 2nd / 70

Commenced with light air heading to the S.W. same part of the day.

Friday June 3rd

one man ash to do the sailed from the Bay Islands. Commenced with nearly a calm at light breeze from the N.E. by. Took our water to do. Latter part fresh breeze from the N.E. in all the lighter sails during S.W.

Saturday June 4th / 70

Bay of Islands. Commenced strong from the S.W. at 1 A.M. took to the air at 6 A.M. and raised the land. thick at 8 came to anchor at 12 M. found three Boats & a Ship. Boat Callao (hundred tons) Line & Oak & Ship Europa. Capt. John M. of Falmouth. Received 17 letter sixteen of mail and one of the

Sunday May 5th / 70 June 3rd

fine weather all day. went on shore this afternoon.

Monday May 6th / 70

fine weather all day. employed making out the after hatch. I am not to work all ready for my discharge. This morning the mail arrived I received 1236 from Eliza & some papers.

Tuesday May 7th / 70 June

Commenced squally with rain. I am not at work now. In going and coming when I left Campbell this morning on board the ship. Making the ground tier & getting ready to go water. This morning the Capt. asked me of being on shore as reporting that I had been on shore. I told him what I had said that he had killed my own ship. I told him that I was the same kind I asked a my discharge. He promised to discharge me. For some little previous to this he told me to look out on the deck while he was eating & ordered me of the quarter deck. I went to the me to shut up. I told him I was. When walks forward. He called after me. I asked him if I refused to do. He replied. I told him no. For was going to talk talk. Consequently I did not go to breakfast with him. He told me to stand near some more men forward when he goes out to the conversation. I might infer that if I did not ask for a discharge he would put me in the forecabin. He shook his fist in my face. He did not strike. I received a letter & bunch of papers to do by Capt. Thomas in Bay. How kind you are my little ship.
