offer in being to make every thing pleasant
(I am glad he changed) Thursday June 9th
I am on board the Europa.
I was on board the Albion. I put up my things.
I then went back on board the Europa. I wrote to letter
I believe I was the second order to settle in them.
Believe this line belongs to the margin of the
rule. &

according to the American rule I am entitled to a
proportional part of the cargo to a proportional time
served in the Ship. but I expect they will try to get
out of it. I must not forget to call & get the
Note I gave Capt. Thomas for £100. I don't
remember who I gave it to. Whether to Capt. T^r or to
the Agent of the Albion. or to the Bank Albion.
I shall have to look around & get some small things
I want to settle my wages. & if I can one I will give a
good name in the next ship. I shall be all right
for I am not short but I can leave my whole
wages. for he orders me of the quater & for bid
me to eat at the first table. but told me to
look out for the deck while he was eating
