

Ship. Europa. Bampton Shoal

Thursday July 28th 1870

Fine weather. We whaling among the ship. at 600
saw the boat says to live on the coming day.
The Buck Flaming. Sister of Sydney
Saw several whales to day

Friday July 29

Fine weather. all the ships whaling. two ship boat
struck. and could not get hold of one

Saturday July 30th 1870

Strong breeze all day. saw but a few whales
day at 10th. went and help the Flaming. Flaming
saw a whale

Sunday July 31st 1870

Strong breeze most of the day. latter part moderate
Ship Buck's came to anchor here to night. The
Leander at 1000. I Buck's Locust Capt. S. B. R.
My eye is very sore to night on account of the
bright sunlight when the sun is out.
The whale is rather scarce. none struck to day

Monday August 1st 1870

Fine weather. Whaling. the Bow boat struck
a whale whale belonging to the Oceanic
killed him & took him along side.

Ship. Europa. Tuesday Aug 2nd 1870

Fine weather. two boat of whaling. the remain
cutting a whale. very warm

Wednesday Aug 3rd 1870

Light air & very hot. started the works and
began to sail. Three whales taken to day

Ship. Europa. Bampton Shoal

Thursday August 4th 1870

Very warm & sultry. finished boiling to day. The
Bow Boat struck & killed a small Humpback. took
him along side at 10th.

Friday August 5th 1870

For part light breeze. Middle part strong with
rain. Employed cutting a whale

Saturday August 6th 1870

For part rain. Middle part calm. Latter part
moderate breeze. Two whales taken to day, one was
taken by shooting a barrel in him

Sunday August 7th 1870

Strong breeze. Employed boiling three boats &
whaling

Monday August 8th 1870

Fresh breeze all day. boat whaling. Mr. Linn
took some fish, on board of Buck Flaming
- Thicker & fell them with water

Tuesday August 9th 1870

Fine weather all day. three boats of whaling
W. B. struck & killed him a large one. took
him along side at 4th

Wednesday August 10th 1870

Fine weather. Three boats of whaling. Employed
cutting in a large Humpback

Thursday August 11th 1870

I believe I have made a mistake of one day

boiling three boats & whaling

fine weather. boiling three boats of whaling

Sunday Aug 13th 1870

Fine weather. Three boats of whaling. Bow Boat
on board cooping oil. latter part rainy
