 B. L. 3. Employed stoving iron oil. Three boats of iron
 B. Boat - drove K and flanked

Monday August 15th 70.
Fine weather. no whaling in the bay, boats
all cruising away of shore.
This evening is a calm, and I can hear the money bells
on board of the regrest ship, & I am homesick.
I feel just as I used to night when I was
over to Falmouth how homesick I used to
feel when Eliza used to slip over to Poughkeepsie.

Tuesday August 16
 Fine weather, all four boats of whaling. Almost
 out of sight of the shipping.

137 Weeks Wednesday August 17
Jan. 11. (Beautiful weather the snow would call
Darling's wife very calm for whaling. All four boats
of whaling. The Capt. took the starboard
boat, very few whales in shore, but
plenty ten or twelve miles off shore

Thursday August 18th/70
Five boxes from the ship all same kind
of whaling. To day shifted the cargo
the old starboard boat & put it in the
new boat, (red streak boat) the Capt. went
to sea. Three whales taken to day by
different ships.

Friday August 19th /70
Fresh breeze from the N^o - all four boats
of whaling. The Capt. lowering the Star board gear
a sport line, the third had made & myself
taking turns lowering the bow boat.
About 4 P.M. the Starboard boat struck a log
the bow star came off the line & swept off
one man overboard and we lost the horse
& my God had mercy on his soul, & may be more than
& more precious, & be prepared for my final end

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Saturday August 20th 76
Wrote letters to his from the P. M. at
5 P. M. sent two letters to Miss the Bank
Depot. Now in a whale got to the P. M.
about 9 P. M., I felt real bad at heart got
some cold & my throat is beautiful sore
went to bed but a big sin. he me
I could not sleep

Sunday August 21st / 78
 Fine weather a number of seals in
 the Bay, our boat chasing the mass of
 the dolphins the Bay. I feel real sick
 today. Have been to bed most of the
 day.

Monday August 22nd
Fine weather, snow & light for whaling
all four boats of whaling
I feel real sick just such an ill turn as
I had given to Halmguth a short time before
I sailed in this ship / 87 my throat is as sore
as though it was ulcerated. The Capt. tells me
if there is any thing in the medicine chest I
want to help myself to it, to night I have
taken a big, sweet,

B.2. Tuesday August 23rd/70
Nearly calm, I feel much better today
after the sweet think now I shall come along
all right if I do not take extra cold. How
I should like to have my wife to bathe my
burning brow, yet this is the time we miss our better
half in the hour of sickness, we miss our loving
injection for a gentle loving wife, just such a
one as I have got, I say I be a good a
thousand as the other been a wife
