Tuesday Dec 3, 1844 Begins with strong breeze from N.W. & hazy. Middle the same later strong breeze and thick weather. Saw several Whales two ranged to Lure, about 34 35 75-85 No Cs

Wednesday Dec 4 Begins with heavy breeze from N.W. with thick rain. Weather middle part thick rain. Weather later fog in Squall. Saw Whales and chased hard back to day. Ends with fog and plenty of Whales

Lat 34 45 Long 75 40

Thursday Dec 5 Begins with fog. Middle strong breeze from N.W. with thick rain. Weather later weather the same. Flood down 100 barrels of Oil, No Whales in site to day.

Friday Dec the 6. Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. and hazy. Middle and later fine weather. Saw Whales and chased Flood twice to day.

Lat 36 46 Long 75 55

Saturday Dec the 7. Begins with fine weather. Wind S.W. by S. Wind and later fine weather. Late breeze from W. S.W. At 11 A.M. took a blasted Whale. A long side and cut him in. Lat the bone

Lat 36 30 Long 76 04

Sunday Dec the 8. Begins with like breeze from W. Middle and later like breeze from W. & S.W. No Whales in site to day. 500 in site. The bark endeavor of New Bedford 18 or hundred. Capt. Labor waiting one whale.

Lat 37 00 Long 76 36

Monday Dec the 9, 1844 Begins with like breeze from S.W. by W. Middle and later strong breeze from N.W. Flood down 45 barrels of Oil. Spoke Ship Lumber. Capt. Rogers of New London & Ships in site to day. And No Whales

Lat 37 05 Long 75 40

Tuesday Dec the 10. Begins with strong breeze from N.W. Middle and later strong breeze and thick weather. Saw 3 Whales took one and cut him in thick weather. Wind S.W. by W.

Lat 37 40 Long 76 00

Wednesday Dec the 11 Begins with strong breeze and hazy weather. Middle the same later rain. At 12 M. Wind W. S.W. Saw Whales and chased 6 Ships in site.

Lat 37 55 76 50

Thursday Dec the 12, Begins with like breeze from W. and pleasant weather. Middle the same later strong breeze from W. & S.W. No site Whales in site to day.

Lat 37 30 Long 77 02

Friday Dec the 13. Begins with strong breeze from W. At 10 P.M. Flood down Middle Squall. Weather later more moderate. Wind W. S.W. No Whales in site to day.

Lat 37 18 Long 77 00

Saturday Dec the 14 Begins with like breeze from S.W. and hazy with a heavy swell. Middle and later strong breeze from N.W. At 2 P.M. Spoke Charles Phillips. At 5 Made the Land of Amsterdam
