and fog. Made like breeze from E. & W. for
later fog in Squalls saw Whales and chased
at 3 PM Made the Land Mount Chukony
Lat 53° 40' Long

Tuesday July the 15. Begins with fine
breezes from E. & W. Made like this and rarer
Later the same saw Whales and chased land in sight
No Obs

Wednesday July the 16. Begins with like
breezes from E. and rarer, Made thick weather
Later calm spoke the President of America Capt
Bruster 500 barrels saw Whales and chased
Lat 53° 40'

Thursday July the 17. Begins with Calms
Made and later thick rarer weather No Whales in
sight to day saw eight ships only one a sailing saw
a Russian Schooner, Land in sight
No Obs

Friday July the 18. Begins with thick
rarer weather Made and later like breeze from
S.E. and rarer spoke the President and Capt
Capt upon of New Bedford Land in sight
Lat 52° 50'

Saturday July the 19. Begins with like breeze
from S.E. Made and later from E. Good Coast to the shore
saw plenty of humpback stood off shore at 6 PM
saw 5 or 6 Whales and chased. Polaski having No Obs

Sunday July the 20. Begins with like breeze
from S.E. Made and later like breeze from
E. No White Whale in sight to day, Land 20 miles off
Lat 52° 45' Long 159° 34'

Monday July the 21. Begins with Calms
Made and later strong breezes from S.E.
Later spoke ship Astorak Waller very tender
No Whales

Tuesday July the 22. Commenced with heavy
breezes from Made and later strong gales
from S.W. with thick rarer weather
No Obs

Wednesday July the 23. Begins with bad weather
Made heavy breezes later more moderate wind
West and rarer saw plenty of the black
No Obs land in sight

Thursday July the 24. Begins with fine
weather Wind W.S.W. Made and later strong
breezes from E. saw 3 Whales spoke ship Marion
Lat 52° 45' Long 160° 13'

Friday July the 25. Begins with heavy breezes
from E.W. Made and later thick fog wind
E.S.W. saw nothing to day
No Obs

Saturday July the 26. Begins with moderate
breezes from E.W. and fog, Made and later
Wind E. again Squalls at 9 AM. and for Whales
called for took them a long side and cured them
as well as we could one by a volume of heavy
breezes from E. and fog
