Tuesday May 19th Begins with light breezes from S.W. with fog. Made and later fine weather. Saw several Whales and Chased. Lat 52° 10' Long 153° 31'

Wednesday May 20th Begins with fine weather. Wind S.W. with fog. Made and later strong breezes from S.E. Saw Whales and Chased. Cook Ship. Consists of 18 Bedford Capt. Norton. No Obs.

Thursday May 21st Begins with strong breezes and thick weather. Made and later strong breezes from S.W. with thick weather. Saw 3 Whales and Chased. Lat 52° 15'

Friday May 22nd Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. Made and later strong breezes from S.W. No Obs.

Saturday May 23rd Begins with strong breezes from S.W. Made and later fine weather. Saw Whales and Chased twice. Chased. Saw and Lost the Whales by Bad Management. Lat 52° 10' Long 154° 31'

Sunday May 24th Begins with fine weather. At 7 AM. Saw 4 Whales. At 12 PM. took one alongside and cut pig in. Cook. Bart. Columbia. At Bedford ends with heavy weather. No Obs.

Monday May 25th Begins with heavy weather. Made strong breezes from S.E. Later moderate breezes from S.E. Saw one Whale. Lat 52° 40' Long 154° 49'

Tuesday May 26th Begins with light breezes with a heavy swell. Made and later strong breezes from S.W. with a heavy swell. Saw Whales. No Obs.

Wednesday May 27th Begins with heavy weather. Made and later heavy breezes from S.W. with a heavy swell. Saw one Whale. Lat 52° 19'

Thursday May 28th Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. Made and later fine weather. Saw plenty of Whales three times. Got nothing. Spoke the Commodore. Lat 52° 19' Long 155° 40'

Friday May 29th Begins with fine weather. At 11 AM. saw fine weather and plenty of Whales. Chased all day. Saw 5 times. Lat 52° 34' Long 155° 35'

Saturday May 30th Begins with light breezes from S.W. At 12 PM. Sailed for Whales. At 4 PM. took one alongside. Mr. Brown boat badly. Saw four. One broke his leg by the Whales. Lost one line and with heavy weather. Lat 52° 33'

Sunday May 31st Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. At daylight. Commenced cutting to the chase of Whales. At 11 PM. started. Placed. Chased. Strong breezes from S.W. with a heavy swell. Saw one Whale. No Obs.
