Thursday June the 4. Begins with fine weather. Middle and later fine weather. Head down 55 barrels of oil. Saw Whales and chased. Lat 52.48 Long 154.25

Friday June the 5. Begins with strong breezes from N.W. Middle and later strong breezes from N.W. Head down 55 barrels of oil. Lat 52.10 Long 154.30

Saturday June the 6. Begins with strong breezes. Middle fine. Later heavy breezes from S.W. with equals. Saw Whales. Lat 51.48 Long 154.32

Sunday June the 7. Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. Middle and later heavy breezes from S.W. and heavy nothing in sight. Lat 52.20 Long 154.20

Monday June the 8. Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. with fine middle. Head down 55 barrels of oil. Lat 52.30 Long 153.51

Tuesday June the 9. Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. Middle and later heavy breezes from S.W. No Obs.

Wednesday June the 10. Begins with strong breezes from S.W. Middle and later strong breezes from S.W. Spoke ship. Drove N. Lat 51.52 Long 153.57

Thursday June the 11. Begins with heavy breezes from S.W. Middle and later more moderate. Saw Whales and chased. Lat 52.10 Long 153.20

Friday June the 12. Begins with light breezes from S.W. Middle and later fine weather. Saw 10 Whales and chased. Lat 52.28 Long 152.20

Saturday June the 13. Begins with fine weather. Middle and later fine weather. Saw 5 Whales. Struck one and drove. Spoke ship today from Harbor. Capt. Robinson. Lat 52.30 Long 153.54

Sunday June the 14. Begins with strong breezes from S.W. Middle and later moderate with fog. Spoke the Lancelot. Lat 52.30 Long 153.54

Monday June the 15. Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. and chased. Spoke ship. Conductor Capt. Williams of Hingham. No Obs.
