Commences with hazy weather & strong Trades the Bark heading to the N. at 4 P.M. were to the S.E. a large number of fish around the Ship.

Bark steering S.W. so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.44 Long 32.56.

Friday 9

Commences with strong trades the Bark steering S.W. at 3 P.M. by the wind heading S.E. at 7 P.M. were to the E. one sail to the N.E. & S.

Latter part strong trades the Bark steering to the westward so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.44 Long 33.04

Saturday 10

Commences with fine weather & moderate trades the Bark heading to the S. at 1 o'clock were to the N. Latter part fine so ends this 24 hours

Lat 16.28 Long 33.01

Sunday 11

Commences with fine weather & light trades the Bark heading to the N. saw grampases at 6 P.M. were to the S.E. Latter part

fine weather & strong

trades the Bark heading to the S.E. at 7 o'clock were to the N. So ends this 24 hours Lat 16.17

Long 33.50

Monday 12

Commences with fine weather & strong trades the Bark heading to the N. Latter part steering to the westward so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.28

Thursday 13

June 1811

Commences with cloudy weather & strong Trades the Brig steering S.W. at 6 P.M. luffed to the wind heading S.E.

heading S.E. 10 o'clock steering S.W. at 12.30 m so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.11

Wednesday 14

Commences with hazy weather & strong trades the Bark heading to the N. Latter part fine weather & light trades saw white water at 7 o'clock at 10 o'clock saw black fish toward one boat but did not get fast so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.44

Long 34.55. 1.10.

Thursday 15

Commences with fine weather & strong trades the Bark heading to the S.E. one sail to the W. of us. Latter part squally the Brig steering N. by W. so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.38 Long 35.14

Friday 16

Commences with squally weather & strong trades the Bark steering S.W. at 6 P.M. luffed to the wind at 7 P.M. saw black fish

Latter part squally

& strong trades the Bark heading N. at 7 o'clock steering N. by W. so ends this 24 hours Lat 16.25 Long 35.40.

Saturday 17

Commences with thick hazy weather & strong trades the Bark steering S.W.

At 3 P.M. changed signals with Bark St. Thomas of Hamburg.
