

Thursday 13.

July 1881.

Commences with fine weather & calm.
Two boats chasing whales. at 2 P.M. gave up the chase
at 5 1/2. P.M. arrived on board.

Later part. fine weather &
a light breeze from the S.E. the Bark steering S.W.
So ends this 24 hours Lat 31.23 Long 51.53 1/2. Two Sails in

Friday 14.

Commences with fine weather & light
breeze from the S.E. the Bark steering S.W.

Later part. Light breeze from the S.
the Bark heading S.W. So ends this 24 hours.

Lat 31.44 Long 52.48 1/2

Saturday 15

Commences with fine weather and
a light breeze from the W. the Bark heading S
at 1 1/2. P.M. wore to the S.W.

Later part. fine weather
the Bark heading to the W. at 9. P.M. tacked to the S.E.
So ends this 24 hours. Lat 31.38. Long 53.01

Sunday 16.

Commences with fine weather & a light breeze
from the S.W. the Bark heading S.E.

Later part. the same the Bark heading S.E.
So ends this 24 hours Lat 31.40. Long 52.15

Monday 17

Commences with fine weather and a light
breeze from the W. the Bark heading S.W.

Later part the same. the Bark steering S.E. so ends this day
Lat 31.46 Long 52.58.

Tuesday 18.

July 1881.

Commences with fine weather & light air
the Bark steering S.E. the wind from the S.W.
Saw Black fish & porpoises.

Later part. fine weather & a moderate breeze
from the S.E. the Bark heading S. So ends this
24 hours one Brig to the S of a Lat 31.10. Long 52.16

Wednesday 19.

Commences with fine weather and
a moderate breeze from the S.E. the Bark
steering S.W. at 2 P.M. wore to the N.E.

Later part

fine weather & a light breeze
from the S.E. the Bark heading to the N.E.
at 10 P.M. steering S. So ends this 24 hours.
Saw sunfish. Lat 31.47. Long 54.45.

Thursday 20.

Commences with fine weather and
a light breeze. the Bark steering S. at 4 P.M.
wore to the S.W. Later part fine weather
and a light breeze from the E. the Bark heading
S.E. So ends this 24 hours saw a large spar Lat 32.40
Long 52.9.

Friday 21

Commences with fine weather & a light breeze
from the E. the Bark steering S.E. at 2 P.M. wore to the S.
Later part a strong breeze from the E.S.E. the Bark
heading S.E. at 7 P.M. wore to the S. So ends this 24 hours
Lat 32.42. Long 52.34
