

Tuesday 15.

August 1841

Commences with fine weather & calm the Bark? heading to the E. Employed in stowing down Sperm oil. Scatter part. fine weather the wind from the westward. the Bark steering N.E. one sail in sight. Employed in stowing oil. ^{109.11} So ends this 24 hours. Lat 33.06. Long 49.05.

Wednesday 16.

Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the S.W. the Bark heading N.E. at 4 P.M. wore to the S. one sail in sight at 6 P.M. took in the starboard boat for repairs. Scatter part. Strong breeze from the S.W. & squally the Bark steering N.E. Employed in mending the starboard boat. one sail in sight. So ends this 24 hours Lat 33.30 Long 47.54.

Thursday 17.

Commences with squally weather and a strong breeze from the S.W. the Bark steering N.E. at 2 P.M. changed signal with an English Bark at sea down luffed to the wind heading N.W. Scatter part. Raining & a strong breeze from the S.W. the Bark heading S.E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat Long.

Friday 18.

Commenced with fine weather and a light breeze from the N.W. the Bark heading N.E. Scatter part much the same. at 9 A.M. the Captain W. W. Eldredge rose sperm whales. Bearing by compass N.E. by N. 6 miles. at 12 M. Howard & gave chase. So ends this 24 hours Lat 32.30. Long 48.50 W.



Saturday 19.

August.

Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the N.W. the Boat down chasing whales. at 1 P.M. the starboard boat struck a large sperm whale. he sounded & took her line with the waist boat line bent on. the mate got in with the second mate & the whale run & sounded until 10 P.M. & then the mate cut arrived on board at 11 P.M. Scatter part fine weather the Bark steering N.E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 35.06. Long 48.43.

Sunday 20.

Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the S.W. the Bark steering S.E. at 5 P.M. luffed to the wind heading S.E. Scatter part fine weather and a moderate breeze from the W.S.W. the Bark heading to the S. at 8 P.M. wore to the N. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 34.38. Long 47.23.

Monday 21.

Commences with fine weather and a moderate breeze from the W.S.W. the Bark heading to the N.W. Scatter part fine weather and a light breeze from the W. the Bark steering S.E. So ends this 24 hours Lat 35.05. Long 46.11.

Tuesday 22.

Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the W. the Bark steering S.E. at 6 P.M. bent a second handed main topsail & luffed to the wind heading S.W. Scatter part much the same the Bark heading S.E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 35.20 Long 46.35.
