

September 1841.

Monday 18th

Commences with ~~clear~~ weather
 & a Strong breeze from the W. & W. the Bark.
 heading S. the island of Carro Bearing by compass
 S. by W. 30 miles at 5 P.M. wore to the E.
 Employed in hoisting a very heavy swell on
 Scatter Part. Squally & a strong gale from
 the W. & W. the Bark heading N. & W. Employed
 in hoisting & stowing so ends this 24 hours. 080 lbs

Tuesday 19. Flores.

Commences with thick squally weather
 and a strong gale from the W. & W. Employed in hoisting
 Scatter part. Cloudy. The ship rining for
 the Land. Island of Flores.
 So ends this 24 hours.

Wednesday 20.

Commences with fine weather
 and a strong S.W. wind at 12. m. arrived
 off St. Crise & at 1 P.M. the captain went on shore
 at San ~~Ant~~ returned saying off & on.
 Scatter part. Employed in taking off recruits

Thursday 21.

Commences with fine weather
 and a strong breeze from the S.W. Ship off.
 & on at Flores. At 2 P.M. finished at San Juan
 the captain arrived on board & the ship kept
 away for Fayal. Stearing S.E. & S.
 Scatter part thick & rainy at 9. Ach. raised Fayal
 So ends this 24 hours

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Friday 22.

Commences with fine weather
 and a strong breeze from the S.W.
 at 2 1/2 P.M. arrived off the town board
 the Starboard boat & the Captain went
 on shore. Scatter part fine weather
 at 9 o'clock. Entered the Port of Fayal & anchored
 at 7 fathoms of water So ends this 24 hours
 in Port of Fayal

Saturday 23

Commences with fine weather
 and a light breeze. Employed in coopersing
 oil to ship home. Scatter part. much the same
 sent our oil on shore to coast. containing
 by gauge 2497. gallons of Sperm oil
 marked on Bins & denond ~~W. S. F.~~ on the head

Sunday 24.

Commences with rainy weather
 & the wind from the S.W. Employed in
 getting ready for water Scatter part the same

Monday 25

Commences with fine weather
 Employed in taking water
 So ends doing Port duty

Tuesday 26

Commences fine Employed in rining
 water Scatter part the same so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday 27.

Commences with fine weather & ends the same
 doing Port duty
