watch Oct 1st John Devaris, John J. Grady,
William Reynolds, Joseph C. Orana, Jack Munro
& George Needham. So ends this 24 hours.

Monday 2. Commences with fine weather
Starboard watch went on Liberty.
Employed in painting ship

Tuesday 3. Commences with fine weather Employed
in painting ship. Discharged. Sam Davis seaman
this day.

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October 1841
Wednesday 4th Commences with fine weather
Employed in ship's duty. This day shipped
three green hands. Postage So ends this 24 hours.

Thursday 5 Commences with fine weather.
& a light breeze from the S.
Sailed part much the same at 10.00 took
our anchor and left the Harbour of Fajal.
at 5.00 PM the Captain arrived on board & we
left for St Michaels So ends this 24 hours.

Friday 6 Commences with fine weather
and a light breeze from the S.
the ship off & on, at 5.00 PM left Fajal
Sailed part fine. So ends this 24 hours

Saturday 7. Commences with a strong breeze
from the N.W. rose St Michaels about 12.00.

Sailed part fine So ends this 24 hours.

Sunday 8. Commences with fine weather and
a strong breeze from the N.W. the ship off St Michaels.
Sailed part the same. So ends this 24 hours.

Monday 9. Commences with fine weather and a
strong breeze from the N.W. at 2.00 PM the Captain
went on shore for letters the ship off & on for the night
