Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the W. the Bark steering S.S. Saw six backs.

Scatter part. cloudy weather and a moderate breeze from the W. or N.W. saw six backs. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 39.19. Long 25.31.4.

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup>



Commences with thick hazy weather and a light breeze from the W. the Bark steering to the S. at 4 P.M. rose black fish ten and down. Starboard boat struck 5. & got none. waist boat struck 3. & got two. Starboard boat struck two & got one. arrived on board at 8 P.M.

Scatter part. thick rainy weather and a moderate breeze from the E. or E. the Bark steering S.W. by N. So ends this 24 hours Lat 41.20.30. Long 26.38

Thursday 11<sup>th</sup>

Commences with cloudy weather and a moderate breeze from the E. the Bark steering S.W. by N.

Scatter part. much the same. Bark steering S.W. by E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 42.22. Long. 25.50.4.

Friday 12<sup>th</sup>

Commences with thick hazy weather and a strong breeze from the N. the Bark steering S.W. by E. at 8 P.M. by the wind heading S.W. by W.

Scatter part went to the E. or E. So ends this 24 hours Lat 42.36. Long. 25.55

Saturday 13<sup>th</sup>

Commences with thick squally weather and a strong breeze from the S. the Bark heading to the Eastward at 11 P.M. to the W. at

Scatter part. strong gale from the N. at 2 A.M. shot the main top sail took in foresail & fore topsail and here to under storm staysails fore topmast & mainmast. Scatter part moderate breeze from the westward and raining Bark steering S.W. by E. So ends this 24 hours Lat 40.18. Long 25.14

Sunday 14<sup>th</sup>

Commences with thick rainy weather and moderate breeze from the W. the Bark steering S.W. Scatter part much the same. Saw black fish. Scipian So ends this 24 hours. many Alchies Lat 42.00 Long 25.14

Monday 15<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fine weather and a light breeze from the S. the Bark steering S.W. by E. at 4 P.M. Scatter part strong gale from the S.E. the Bark steering S.W. by E. one sail in sight. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 40.13. Long.

Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a strong gale from the S.E. the Bark heading S.W. by E. ship anchor close reef main top sail and fore topsail. Scatter part thick hazy weather and a moderate breeze from the S.W. the Bark heading S.W. by E. at 11 A.M. went to the N.W. at 12.4 pm. Michael Martin rose two wright & halogain S.W. toward So ends this 24 hours Lat 39.33. Long 26.02
