Monday 6

Commences with hazy weather and moderate trades Bark heading S.E. at 4 p. M. were to the N.

Latther Part. fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the S.E. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.32. Long 33.44.25

Tuesday 7

Commences with fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the N. Saw grampuses.

Latther Part. hazy. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.25. Long 33.25.

Wednesday 8

Commences with fine weather and light trades well to the E. Bark heading N.E. to N.

at 5 P.M. Captain Eldredge rose a whale saw him two rising & then was out of sight did not make him out

Latther Part heading S.E. at 8 p. M. Thomas Chelam rose white water bearing by compass S.W. by W. 4 miles

So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.38. Long 33.28

Thursday 9

Commences with fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the N.

Latther Part to the S.W. No sails to the S. as So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.26. Long 34.19.34

Friday 10

Commences with fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the N. saw Porpoises jumpers and a whale one rising but did not see him again rose light to the N.

Latther Part two sails in sight So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.35. Long 34.10

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Saturday 11

Commences with fine weather light trades Bark steering S.W. at 1 P.M. S.W. by S.

at 1 P.M. Changed signals & Longitude with Bark. River Head of River Pool Steaming S.W. at 3 P.M. saw Porpoises

Latther Part. Steering to the S.W. three sails in sight at 2 p. M. the Chief mate rose white water off weather at 5 p. M. Captain W. W. Eldredge rose a shoot of sperm whales off the bow 14 miles going to N.E. quick forward & Starboard boat shook & got a calf took him to the ship at 8 P.M. So ends this 24 hours. Lat 17.05. Long 34.34.

Commences with fine weather and light trades in the Will cut in our whale & stayed up for the day at

Latther Part fine So ends this 24 hours spoke a Spanish Bug bound N. Lat 16.52. Long 34.48

Monday 13

Commences with fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the N. at 2 P.M. started the fires to boil

Latther Part fine So ends this 24 hours. Lat 16.45. Long 34.44.

Tuesday 14

Commences with fine weather and light trades Bark heading to the N. at 3 P.M. shook a grampus and drewed. were to the S. at 8 P.M. finished cooking

Latther Part. fine weather and moderate trades Bark heading to the S. So ends this 24 hours.
