

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

Sunday March 14th 1875
Begin with strong trades, cloudy weather & a rough sea steering brig W by N with all drawing sail set wind E N E watch employed to work on the rigging getting ready for tarring, middle & latter part before weatherate but one (off) latter part much the same watch employed at ship's duty so ends this day

Lat 11° 59' N Long 48° 20' W.

Monday March 15th
Begin with fresh trades & a somewhat sea partly cloudy weather steering brig W by N with all drawing sail set watch employed at ship's duty, middle & latter part fine weather watch employed painting S. B. top of house & fitting rigging so ends

Lat 12° 30' N Long 51° 06' W.

Tuesday March 16th
Begin with fine weather steering brig W by N nothing to be said, watch employed scraping & painting iron work & fitting rigging, saw an ebullish steamer steering N E, middle & latter part fine weather & service the same watch employed scraping deadwood & fitting rigging so ends

Lat 12° 58' N Long 53° 40' W.

Wednesday March 17th
Begin with fine weather steering brig W by N with all drawing sail set watch employed to work on rigging & etc, middle & latter part much the same at 12 midnight steered W watches employed scraping Masts & etc saw one sail steering W so ends

Lat 13° 10' N Long 55° 43' W.

New Bedford Wm. C. B. Russell Master,

Thursday March 18th 1875
Begin with moderate trades steering brig W by S with all square sails set one sail in light watch employed scraping Masts & fitting rigging & etc at 7 P.M. had a squall of wind & rain from E. middle part squally at 12 noon saw the Light on South Point of Barbados latter part fresh trades at 9 A.M. anchored in Carlisle Bay Barbados so ends

In Barbados from March 18th until April 3rd 1875 Discharged Antine Joagim Thomas Wilson Manuel Thomas Wm. & Reynold & Chas. & Fish ran away (received a letter from wife No 1)

In Dominica from April 5th until April 9th 1875 Took 270 lbs water 6 cords wood 2000 lbs yams 1000 lbs Sweet Potatoes 40 bunches bananas 15 Pumpkins 3 Pine Apples

Antine Much the same, Bound to Barbados.
