

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

Wednesday June 2nd 1875

Begins with light easterly wind & fine weather
big heading S. E. saw a stick of timber
& a piece of squid. at sundown weather cloudy.
shortened sail as usual, middle part
nearly calm latter part fine breeze from E. S. E.
at daylight made sail & steered N. N. W.
saw Blackfish porpoises Compuca finbacks
& some large pieces of squid so ends
Lat 33° 27' N Long 41° 45' W.

Thursday June 3rd

Begins with fine weather light breeze from
S steering brig W with all drawing sail
set at 11.30 P.m. wind veered to S. S. W.
at 4 P.m. wind veered to N. S. W. cloudy
atmosphere big by the wind to N. W. at
6 P.m. lowered S. B. & caught a turtle at
sundown shortened sail as usual brig
heading N. N. W. middle & latter part very
strong breeze from S. W. big by the wind to
N. N. W. under short sail weather fit for
no kind of business so ends
Lat 33° 30' N Long 43° 12' W.

Friday June 4th

Begins with almost a gale of wind from S. W.
big by the wind to N. N. W. at 2 P.m. close
reduced the topsail & furled fore sail. a bad
sea running from all directions (saw one
sail) at 4.30 P.m. had a squall from
west with heavy rain wore ship to S. W.
moderate again at 7 P.m. wind S. W. again
middle and latter parts strong breeze
& squally with rain at daylight wore ship
to N. N. W. at 7 A.m. set fore sail ends.
more moderate (saw a humpback)

Lat 33° 48' N Long 44° 00' W.

Saturday June 5th 1875

Begins with fresh breeze from N. S. W. & cloudy
weather steered brig N under close reefed
topsail & fore sail. saw a piece of squid. at sun
down quite moderate but clouds looking in the
southward furled fore sail & luffed by the wind
heading N. W. by W. middle & latter parts
strong breeze wind N. W. at daylight steered
E. N. E. under close reefed topsail & stay sails
so ends

Lat 34° 34' N Long 42° 40' W.

Sunday June 6th

Begins with fresh breeze from N. W. steered
brig E. at 12. e. fore sail (saw finbacks)
at sundown luffed by the wind heading N. N. E.
middle & latter parts moderate at daylight
steered S. E. saw humpbacks lowered S. B.
tried to strike me without success so ends
Lat 34° 28' N Long 41° 45' W.

Monday June 7th

Begins with light airs from N. N. W. steered
S. S. W. with all drawing sail set at 2.30
P.m. saw a large body of Black fish. lowered
all 3 boats and made chase. chased until
5 P.m. without success. saw humpbacks
& porpoises caught one at sundown. calm
took in light sails middle part calm
latter part fine breeze from S. at daylight steered
S. W. at 7 A.m. sent down fore sail to repair
at 9 A.m. passed a whaling bark supposed
it to be the clavier of Edgerton saw some
blackfish & humpbacks a 12 finished
fore sail so ends

Lat 33° 46' N Long 41° 45' W.
