

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

Wednesday Aug 11th

Begins with fine weather wind light from N.E. steering brig S.E. watch employed bailing clearing away head &c at 1 P.M. saw the Ohio take a whale along side. at 4 P.M. raised a school of sperm whales off our weather beam going quick to N.E. Mr. did not lower for them at 6 P.M. tacked ship to N.N.W. wind very light & a heavy swell running. middle & latter part calm watches employed Bailing &c the Ohio in sight Bailing so ends
Lat 35° 00' N Long 44° 31' W.

Thursday Aug 12th

Begins with fine clear weather & calm watch employed Bailing at 6 P.M. cooled down put on Hat beam &c middle part calm until 3 A.M. then had a light air from N by the wind to N.N.W. latter part much the same watch employed stowing down oil (saw porpoises & grampuss) so ends

Lat 35° 28' N Long 44° 42' W.

Friday Aug 13th

Begins with fine weather a nice breeze from W. brig by the wind to N.N.W. watch employed stowing down oil at 4 P.M. finished stowing down at 5:20 P.M. raised breeches off or weather beam but did not see them any more (saw Porpoises & one sail) at sundown took in light sails brig heading S.S.W. middle & latter part fresh breeze from N.N.W. at daylight took in main sail & steered S.E. watch employed washing ship &c at 10 A.M. steered E.S.E. at 12 noon strong breeze luffed by the wind under short sail heading S.S.W. so ends
Lat 35° 28' N Long 44° 07' W.

Saturday Aug 14th 1875

Begins with strong breeze from N. & equally big by the wind to S.S.W. at 2 P.M. had a squall wind shifted to N.W. at sundown wind N.N.E. fresh brig heading N.W. one sail in sight middle part much the same at daylight steered S.S.W. found 3 shrouds of Starboard fore rigging stranded fitted them the best that we could at 10 A.M. steered N. so ends

Lat 35° 04' N Long 44° 35' W.

Sunday Aug 15th

Begins with fine weather wind N with a heavy swell from N.N.W. steering brig S.S.E. at 2 P.M. saw a school of Blackfish at 4 P.M. luffed by the wind to N.E. at sundown reefed the top sail at 8 P.M. brig heading heading N (saw one sail) middle part much the same at 11 P.M. were shut to N.S.W. at 7 A.M. steered S. at 11:30 steered E.S.E. saw a large stock of timber at 11:15 luffed by the wind heading N.E.

Lat 34° 36' N Long 44° 30' W.

Monday Aug 16th

Begins with fine weather brig by the wind heading N.E. by E. at sundown wind very light & quite a swell from the N.W. middle part fresh breeze brig heading N at daylight steered S.E. at 8 A.M. steered E.N.E. saw Porpoises &c so ends

Lat 35° 38' N Long 43° 08' W.
