

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

Wednesday Sept 1st 1875

(Bark Waver)
Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. & equally weather steering brig S.E. at 2:30 P.M. spoke Bark Ware Capt Briggs with 35 blk taken this season gamed untill sundown rose ship to N.W. under short sail. middle & latter parts fresh breeze & cloudy weather saw 3 whales so ends (saw Porpoises)
Lat 36° 16' N Long 35° 50' W.

Thursday Sept 2nd

(Caldia & Waver)
Begins with fresh breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather with frequent rain squalls at sundown went on board the catappa Anthony 4 months out with 180 sperm gamed untill 11 P.M. latter part squally with rain saw 3 whales so ends
Lat 36° 13' N Long 35° 47' W.

Friday Sept 3rd

(Sarah B. Webb)
Begins with light baffling airs from the westward brig by the wind to N.W. at 3 P.M. spoke the Bark Sarah B. Webb sloocum 5 months out with 90 blk sperm at sundown calm at 8:30 P.M. Capt Sloocum went on board middle & latter parts moderate wind N.E. brig on different tacks by the wind 3 whales in sight saw some grampuses so ends
Lat 36° 02' N Long 35° 38' W.

Saturday Sept 4th

Begins with very light airs from S.E. brig by the wind to N.W. at 3 P.M. calm cleared up & down sails (saw Grampuses & Porpoises) & 3 whales in middle & latter parts much the same brig heading to the Northward so ends
Lat 36° 02' N Long 35° 52' W.

Sunday Sept 5th

(Ware)
Begins in fine weather brig by the wind to the N.E. at 4:30 P.M. spoke Bark Ware & gamed untill 1 P.M. middle part calm latter part light airs from N.W. to S.W. brig by the wind on Port tack 2 sails in sight saw 2 grampuses so ends
Lat 36° 03' N Long 36° 06' W.

Monday Sept 6th

(Humphreys)
Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. brig by the wind to N.W. under all sail at 4:30 P.M. raised breeches called them 1 sperm whale got the boats ready but the next rising found them to be Humphreys at sundown shortened sail brig heading N.W. one sail in sight middle & latter parts fine weather brig by the wind to N.E. water employed filling the ground with salt water so ends
Lat 36° 58' N Long 36° 40' W.

Tuesday Sept 7th

(Bark E. B. Phillips)
Begins with fine weather at 12 M tacked ship to N.W. saw grampuses at sundown shortened sail as usual middle & latter parts much the same so ends one sail in sight
Lat 36° 16' N Long 37° 05' W.

Wednesday Sept 8th

(Bark E. B. Phillips)
Begins with fine breeze from N.W. steady brig S.W. untill 3 P.M. then luffed by the wind at 7:30 P.M. spoke Bark E. B. Phillips Francis J Boston 13 months out with 75 blk middle & latter parts Calm so ends
Lat 36° 11' N Long 36° 58' W.
