Sept 20th Continued

Barom at 6 A.M. 29:32 a heavy sea running
at 7 A.M. 29:30 with heavy gusts of wind
at 8 A.M. 29:25 wind N.N.W. partly clear
a heavy head sea. at 9 A.M. 29:25 " "
Dull reef bery. at 10 A.M. 29:25 close reef
berse. at 11 A.M. 29:26 wind N.W. strong
so ends this day
Lat 39:53 N Long 28:28 W

Tuesday Sept 21st

Begin with a fresh gale from N.W. by
lying to heading S.W. by S. Barom standing
on 29:26 saw 2 large ships steering E.N.E.
at 4 P.M. wind backed to W. and squally
at 7 P.M. Barom standing the same and
the weather cloudy with quite heavy squalls
brig heading S.W. by S. middle part weather
much the same at 9 A.M. Barom down to 28:18
at 4 A.M. sudden thick & rain wind S.S.W.
at 6 A.M. Barom 29:08 nearly calm with
heavy rain at 8 A.M. 29:10 calm & rain
at 9 A.M. 28:96 light wind from N.E. & rain
steered N by N at 10 A.M. Barom standing
28:96 wind the same at 11 A.M. lighted
up saw the Island of Graciosa blowing S by W.
20 miles off also saw St. George & all
the wind came out N.W. at 12 P.M. 28:94
so ends weather looking very bad.

Wednesday Sept 22nd

Begin with a fresh gale from N.W. with
heavy squalls of wind & rain steered for the
east end of Graciosa Barom standing on 28:94
at 4 P.M. passed the island weather looking better
at 7 P.M. Graciosa bore N by heading for the
middle of St. George with a reefed top sail breeze
& a heavy squall from N.W. Secira bearing
S.E. Barom on 28:98, in

Sept 22nd Continued

Middle part more moderate at 9 P.M. went ship
to N.W. latter part strong breeze & squally &
suggested at 10 A.M. steered S.E. under double
reefed top sail fore sail staysail & top sail
had one or two heavy squalls with rain Barom
standing on 29:07 in saw one sail so ends
with the Island of Graciosa bearing S,

Thursday Sept 23rd

Begin with strong breeze and squally wind
N.W. steering by S.E. for the N.E. side of
Graciosa at 4 P.M. passed the Town of Pagan
& steered S.E. wind baffling from N.W. to N.
cloudy atmosphere with frequent rain
squalls Mercury rising at 7 P.M. standing
on 29:33 middle part very strong breeze &
suggested at 3 A.M. made the Island of
St. Michael about 3 miles off luffed to the
wind & lay to until 8 A.M. then kept off & ran
down in to the harbor of Ponta del Grade
at 10:30 A.M. and I gave up the vessel in
charge of the pilot to moor & went on shore
so ends this day

In St. Michael from Sept 23rd until
Oct 9th. Thomas Dal, Geo Ryan Andrew Jones
Frank Garcia Manuel Louisa Simon Santos
& Antonio Peter ran away caught them all
but Antonio Peter run again swam on shore
with bombs on, on the 8th sent Mr. Benton
out with the vessel until the 13th then
I came on board at 11:30 A.M. & steered
S. Received letter from wife No. 3
