

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

(Cruising On Cornett Ground)
(Chase Blackfish)Thursday Nov 4th 1875

Begins with a fine breeze from Eastward
brig by the wind heading S by E. watch
employed boiling blackfish blubber at
4:30 P.M. finished & coiled down at sun-
down took in light sails & hauled up foresail.
middle part much the same latter part
wind S.E. at 8:30 A.M. tacked ship to E.N.E.
watch employed stowing down B & C. sails
Lat 6:56 N Long 20:50 W

Friday Nov 5th

Begins with light airs from S.E. brig by
the wind heading S by N at 3 P.M. calm
at 7 P.M. calm blackfish around the ship.
middle & latter part calm so ends
Lat 7:26 N Long 19:52 W

Saturday Nov 6th

Begins with a light breeze at 2 P.M. had a light
air from S.E. brig by the wind to E.N.E.
at 3 P.M. had a squall from S.E. had a
fine breeze until 6 P.M. then had a squall
from E that killed the wind. at 7 P.M.
calm again saw some blackfish & one sail.
middle part light airs from E to S.E. at 12 m
were ship to E.N.E. latter part moderate
brig heading from E.N.E. to N.N.E.
one sail in sight so ends
Lat 7:40 N Long 19:25 W

Sunday Nov 7th 1875

Begins with a light air from S.E. to E brig
heading to the N.E. at 3 P.M. saw a school
of blackfish going quick to windward. at
4 P.M. saw another school going to leeward
lowered all 3 boats for them without success
returned on board at 6 P.M. wore ship to
S.E. & took in light sails, middle & latter
parts light breeze from E to S.E. brig on Southern
tack. at 7:15 A.M. put George Ryan in the
rigging for fighting saw one sail &
drove him back so ends
Lat 7:01 N Long 19:15 W

(Chase Blackfish)

Monday Nov 8th

Begins with light breezes from the eastward
brig by the wind to S. at 2:30 P.M.
had a squall from S.E. at 3 P.M. tacked
ship to E. at 4 P.M. began promised
to do better I let him down out of the
rigging after having him there 9 hours.
at 5 P.M. had a squall from E.S.E. of
wind & rain at 6 P.M. shortened sail
at 7 P.M. still raining nearly calm brig
heading N.E. middle & latter part calm
windy & cloudy rainy &c brig heading
different ways so ends (No Observation)

Tuesday Nov 9th

Begins with light airs from S.E. brig by the
wind to E.N.E. at 3 P.M. had a squall from
the eastward wore ship to S. had heavy
rain & continued till 11 m. took in light
sails & reefed, top sail, middle & latter
part light airs brig heading from S to N.W.
saw porpoises so ends
