

Remarks On Board Brig E. C. Adams of

Wednesday Nov 10th 1875

Begins with a calm brig lying under
sheet sail. at 8 P.m. still calm and
cloudy middle part calm untill 1 P.m.
then squally untill daylight then a steady
breeze from S.E. & baffling untill the
end of this day (saw Porpoises)
Lat 6° 12' N Long 19° 06' W.

Thursday Nov 11th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S.E.
to S. by the wind to S. & west
under all sail. at 5:30 P.m. had a
squall from S and continual squalls
untill 1 P.m. breeze heading from S. to W.
then S.W. by S.W. middle part cloudy latter
part squally big heading from S.W. to
S. W. by W so ends
Lat 4° 45' N Long 19° 18' W.

Friday Nov 12th

Begins with various kinds of weather
& wind baffling & squally at 4 P.m.
wind veered to S.W. light tacked ship
to S.E. & at 6 P.m. wind veered to S.W.
in a squall at 7 P.m. wind S.W. tacked
ship again to N. by S. weather thick &
raining with a 4 knot breeze vessel under
all sail. middle part squally & rain
latter part very moderate big heading
from S.W. to N.W. with all sail
set (saw 2 schools of small blackfish
& schools of porpoises & 2 finbacks)
so ends this day.

Lat 3° 56' N Long 19° 43' W.

Saturday Nov 13th 1875

Begins with very light airs from S.E. to S.
drift by the wind to S.W. at 4 P.m. had a
squall from S.E. that killed the wind at 6
P.m. had another of a few minutes duration
after which was nearly calm. cloudy atmosphere
(saw a finback) (Caught a dolphin) middle
part fine breeze from S.W. untill 12 then
moderate untill 8 A.m. then a strong
breeze untill 11 A.m. then moderate &
sailing untill the end big heading from
S.W. by S. to N.W. (No Observations)

Sunday Nov 14th

Begins with light wind & sailing weather
relaxed untill 2 P.m. then clouded up
after a light baffling wind big heading
from S.W. by S. to N.W. (saw one
sail bound to S.E.) at 7 P.m. a fine
breeze big heading S.W. with all sail
set, middle & latter part strong trades
& a rough sea big heading from S.W. to
N.W. by N. saw 2 sails at daylight took
in Gaff top sail so ends
Lat 1° 28' N Long 22° 10' W.

Monday Nov 15th

Begins with very strong trades big heading
about S.W. by W. at 1 P.m. took in
fly jib & put one reef in mainsail & sail
in light bound Southward. at 7 P.m. more
moderate & more sea. middle & latter
parts more moderate at 2 A.m. set
fly jib one sail in sight big
heading S.W. & S.W. by W so ends

Lat 00° 47' N Long 23° 25' W.
