

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams of

Tuesday Nov 16th 1875

Begin with fine weather with fresh trades
beginning big heading from S.W. to S.W.
by W. with all sail set except Gaff topsail
(one sail in sight (saw a finback) middle
& latter parts fresh trades big heading
from S.W. to S.W. (one sail in sight)
So ends this day

Lat 3° 24' S Long 24° 50' W.

Wednesday Nov 17th

Begin with fresh trades from S.E. &
a smooth sea big heading S.W. under
all sail except Gaff topsail (one sail
in sight) middle & latter parts wind &
weather much the same so ends

Lat 5° 56' S Long 26° 04' W.

Thursday Nov 18th

Begin with fine weather wind S.E.
steering big S.W. by S. with all sail
set. Watch employed overhauling
boat-tackles. at 5 P.M. wind veered to
E.S.E. middle & latter parts much
the same (saw 2 sail & a finback)
Lat 8° 52' S Long 26° 36' W.

Friday Nov 19th

Begin with fine weather wind moderate
from E.S.E. steering big S.W. by S. with
all sail set 2 sail in sight at 6 P.M.
wind veered to S.E. middle & latter
parts much the same saw one sail &
saw porpoise so ends

Lat 10° 44' S Long 27° 46' W.

(Bound to the Abolition Banks)

New Bedford William E. Brownell Master

Saturday Nov 20th 1875

Begin with light wind from E.S.E. steering
big S.W. by W. with all drawing sail set
(one sail in sight) (can see nothing about
here that indicates whales go and going
to keep along to the Abolition Banks)
middle & latter fresh trades from S.E. to
E saw 2 sail so ends (saw finbacks)
Lat 12° 25' S Long 29° 32' W.

Sunday Nov 21st

Begin with fresh trades from N.E. steering
big S.W. by W. with square sails set (saw
one sail) middle & latter parts much
the same (saw one sail) so ends
Lat 13° 40' S Long 30° 35' W.

Monday Nov 22nd

Begin with light trades from E.N.E.
steering big N.W. by W. with square sails set
(one sail in sight) middle part much
the same latter part fresh breeze &
squally. watch employed breaking out for
bread &c so ends
Lat 14° 50' S Long 31° 58' W.

Tuesday Nov 23rd

Begin with fresh trades from E.N.E.
steering big N.W. by W. with square sail
set. Watch employed shifting Reef & Park
from casks to Bbs. & painting waist-
coat under the ceiling. (saw some porpoises)
middle & latter parts strong trades
& a rough sea (saw some porpoises
vine sail) Tanned fish guys so ends
Lat 16° 23' S Long 33° 35' W.
