

Remarks On Board Brig E. H. Adams

Friday June 16th
Begins with light trade at 5 P.M. I
came on board. made all sail &
steered brig N middle point first
weather latter part same so ends
Lat 14° 44' N Long 60° 09' W.

Saturday June 17th
Begins with light trade &
fine weather steering brig N by E with
all sail set. middle & latter parts
much the same at daylight steered
N by W at 10 A.M. saw one sail so ends
Lat 16° 52' N Long 60° 00' W.

Sunday June 18th
Begins with moderate trade from
E. S. E steering brig N. N. W. with all sail
set same as sail & some from passes.
middle & latter parts fresh trade at 6 A.M.
steered N. W. by N so ends this day
Lat 18° 59' N Long 61° 15' W.

Monday June 19th
Begins with fresh trade steering
brig N. W. by N with all sail set except
jib middle & latter parts much the same
Lat 20° 54' N Long 63° 04' W.

Tuesday June 20th
Begins with fresh trade steering brig
N. W. with all sail set except jib. middle
& latter parts more moderate so ends
Lat 22° 45' N Long 64° 58' W.

Bound to Charleston Ground.

Wednesday June 21st 1876
Begins with light trade from E. S. E
steering brig N. W. by N with all sail set except
jib (nothing to be seen middle point much).
The same latter part wind very light from S. E.
took in all but square sails steering N. W. so ends
Lat 24° 17' N Long 66° 20' W.

Thursday June 22nd
Begins with very light wind from S. E.
& a smoky atmosphere steering brig N. W.
with square sails set (saw one dolphin)
middle & latter parts much the same
watch employed repairing main star sail so ends
Lat 25° 11' N Long 67° 24' W.

Friday June 23rd
Begins with very light air from S. E.
at 4 P.M. wind veered to S. W. at 6 P.M.
calm & cloudy with lightning & distant
thunder at 7.30 P.M. light air from E. S. E with
drizzling rain. steering brig N. W. middle
& latter parts moderate with rain squalls
watch employed making spungies so ends
Lat 26° 00' N Long 68° 08' W.

Saturday June 24th
Begins with light air from S steering
brig N. W. by N at 2.30 P.M. began to
rain at 3 P.M. wind veered to N. W.
by the wind to N. W. by W. took in light
sails & main sail & reefed topsail.
a fresh breeze & heavy rain at 7 P.M.
moderate with heavy rain. continued to
rain until 11 P.M. then had a light air from
S. E. steered N. W. by N latter part wind much the
same with frequent rain squalls so ends
Lat 26° 46' N Long 68° 38' W.
