Tuesday Oct 20th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from S E and good weather headed S W 1/2 S Through the night fresh breeze and cloudy headed S W 1/2 S Latter part pulled the galant sail and got up sail hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 30-29 Long 43-00

Wednesday Oct 21st

First part this twenty four hours fresh breeze from S E and cloudy weather headed S by W Middle and Latter part headed S E hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 28-39 Long 43-00

Thursday Oct 22nd

First part this twenty four hours fresh breeze from S E and cloudy weather headed S by E Middle and Latter part squally and heavy sea headed S E hands employed in ship duty so ends.

First part this twenty four hours strong easterly wind and heavy sea headed S E Through the night squally Latter part fresh breeze hands employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 25-34 Long 41-46 W

Saturday Oct 24th

This twenty four hours commence with fresh breeze from S E and cloudy weather headed S by E At 6 1/2 p m wind hauled to the Southward back ship headed S E Through the night the same At 5 p m tack ship and stood to the Southward headed S by E 1/2 E the remainder of the day the same hands employed in ship duty so ends.
