Wednesday Nov 18th

First part this twenty four hours strong breeze from S E and passing clouds headed S W Middle and Latter part the same hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 1° 30' N Long 24° 48' W

Thursday Nov 19th

This day commences with fine S E trade and good weather headed S W Middle and Latter part headed S W by S saw two sails hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 10° 16' S Long 25° 04'

Friday Nov 20th

First part this twenty four hours commence with fine S E trade and good weather headed S W by S Through the night headed S E W Latter part strong trade headed S W by S so ends

Lat 2° 05' S Long 20° 55' W

Saturday Nov 21st

First part this twenty four hours strong S E trades and passing clouds headed S W by S Middle and Latter part headed S W by S 1/2 S hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 4° 05' S Long 28° 20'

Sunday Nov 22nd

First part this twenty four hours fine S E trades and good weather headed S W by S 1/2 S Middle and Latter part more moderate and cloudy so ends

Lat 5° 52' S Long 29° 28' W

Monday Nov 23rd

First part this twenty four hours light S E trades and calm headed S W by S Middle part wind hauled to the eastward steered S by W Latter part fine breeze and squally employed in repairing the old jib and rip the old top sail so ends

Lat 7° 21' S Long 29° 41' W
