

Remarks on board of Brig

Monday Dec 28th 1874

This day commences with light breeze from N'E and good weather steered S by E at 6 p m spoke Bark Hadley Capt came on board of as at sun down short in sails Through the night the same Latter part set the sails and steered S by E so ends with light breeze hauling to the S E.

Lat 18° 21' S Long 35° 35' W

Tuesday Dec 29th 1874

This twenty four hours commences with light breeze from S E and passing clouds headed S by W saw Bark Hadley at sun down short in sails employed in making sail for S B Through the night weather the same at day light set the sails had some rain squalls so ends no obs sun obscured.

Wednesday Dec 30th 1874

First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from S E and cloudy weather headed S by W saw a sail to the southward at sun down short in sails Through the night the same day light set all of the sails and headed S employed in ship duty saw two sails so ends.

Lat 19° 40' Long 36° 50'

Thursday Dec 31st 1874

This twenty four hours commences with light breeze from Eastward and cloudy weather steered South at sun down short in sails Through the night the same at day light set the sails and steered S by W had several squalls employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 20° 47' S Long 35° 51'

Friday January 1st New Year 1875

This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from E N E and cloudy weather steered S by W at sun down furled the light sails Middle part steered the same under of all top sail Latter part strong breeze steered S by W & W so ends.

Lat 22° 41' S Long 37° 04'

Saturday Jan 2nd

This twenty four hours commences with strong breeze from N E and cloudy weather steered S by W hands employed in ship duty saw 4 sails at sun down short in sails and hove to headed E by S Through the night the same at morning strong breeze kept her off S E so ends.

Lat 24° 01' Long 35° 32'
