Friday Jan 15th

This twenty four hours commences with fresh breeze from NNE and fair weather. Sheered WNW at 3 p m hvy to head NNE at sun down short in sails. Through the night the same at day light strong breeze wore ship headed E by S saw a sail bound to the Southward so ends. Antone sick.

Saturday Jan 16th

This twenty four hours commences with strong breeze from NE and cloudy weather headed E by S at sun down tack ship headed N. Through the night strong breeze headed NNE at day light wore ship headed E so ends with strong breeze Antone sick.

Lat 26°31 Long 38°42

Sunday Jan 17th

This day commences with strong breeze from NNE and cloudy weather headed E at 2 p m wind moderated set the top sail and jib first part the night wind hauled to the Northward at Midnight headed NE Latter part fair weather set the sails and sheered NE so ends. Antone sick.

Monday Jan 18th

This day commences with fine breeze from NNE and fair weather headed NE at sun down short in sails. Through the night wind hauled NW headed N Latter part wind NW headed to the Westward employed in ratline down the main top mast rigging at 10 A m commence to rain saw 2 sails so ends no obs. Antone sick.

Tuesday Jan 19th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from Southward and rainy weather headed WNW at sun down tack ship headed ENE. Through the night moderate headed E Latter part fine breeze and cloudy weather under of all sails no obs employed in ship duty so ends. Antone sick.

Wednesday Jan 20th

First part this twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from Southward and cloudy weather headed E by N at 3 p m commence to rain furled the light sails At 4 p m furled the main sail and reef the top sail 8 stope running Middle and Latter part moderate wind from Southward headed to the eastward employed in ship duty so ends. Antone sick.
