Tuesday Jan 25th

This twenty four hours commences with light winds from Northward rain squalls and heavy sea headed W N W under of short sails at 3-30 p m set the fore sail breakout the new try sail and set it Middle and Leathier part fine weather At day hah! set the sails and employed in shifting fresh water and ^{down} the bil down at noon finish stowing so ends Antone sick.

Lat 25-09 Long 36-50

Wednesday Jan 27th

This twenty four hours commences with moderate wind from N N E and good weather headed N W at 3 p m finish showing the main hatches sun down show in sails Through the night headed N At day hah! set the sails wore ship headed E employed in repairing the fore top mast stay hah! so ends

Lat 25-07 Long 35-50

Thursday Jan 28th

This day commences with light breeze from E N E and good weather headed to E employed in repairing the stay sail at 3 p m finish it and bent it on sun down short in sails wore ship headed N Through the night the same at day light set the sails and steered W N W employed in repairing the main stay saw several sails so ends. This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze and good weather showed W N W employed in repairing the main stay at 2 p m got the stay ready and set it up sun down wore ship and short in sails headed E Later part fresh breeze from E N E wore ship headed N W hands employed in ship duty so ends. Lat 25-34 Long 36-15

Saturday Jan 30th

This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from Northward and fair weather headed N W by W at 3 p m had squall from Southward with some rain headed to the Westward reefed the top sail Through the night fair weather Later part calm and rainy At 10-30 a m cleared up so ends no obs sun obscured Antone sick.

Sunday Jan 31st

This twenty four hours commences with calm and cloudy weather under of short sails headed to the southward At 6 p m wore ship headed N E Through the night fresh gale from N E Later part wind increase headed N W at 9 a m wore ship headed E E so ends with strong gale and rainy weather. no obs Antone sick.
