Tuesday 29th

A No light breeze and fair weather at 7 A M some of the starboard watch came on board Thomas Wilson and Manuel Thomas runaway at 8 A M the starboard watch went on shore hands employed in painting the vessel out side P No the same so ends.

Tuesday March 30th

A No fine breeze and passing clouds at 7 A M some of the port watch came on board Charles Fisher, William Reynolds Arte Bisan, runaway at 8 A M starboard watch went on shore through the day employed in ship duty so ends

Wednesday March 31st

A No fine breeze and good weather at 7 A M starboard watch came on board at 8 Port watch went on shore at 1 p.m. a basket came from side with 2 casks of molasses and some of the ship stores so ends

Thursday April 1st

A No light breeze and fine weather at 7 A M the port watch came on board the liberty finished unbutton the main sail and employed in repairing it so ends

Friday April 2nd

A No light breeze and fine weather employed in repairing the main sail at noon finish it employed in getting ready for sea at 1 p.m. Capt ship three men and send them on board so ends Antonio Peter, Fitz Goddard Lacarus Pina.

Saturday April 3rd

A No fine breeze and good weather Capt went on board of school ship and ship 3 men. Henry Pearson, George Boyan, Andrew Jones, at 4 1/2 p.m. got under way through the night headed to the N.W. by N.W. so ends.

Sunday April 4th

A No fine breeze and good weather steered N.W. at day light, saw St. Lucia through the pass by Marshies so ends headed to N.W.
