Monday Aug 16th

This twenty four hours commences with light breeze from N^W and fair weather headed N^W & At sun down short on sails Through the night strong breeze from W^NW Latter part the same at day light steered N^E At 11 A^m huf to headed N Employed in putting preventive shroud in fore rigging so ends

Tuesday Aug 17th

This twenty four hours commence with fresh breeze from W^NW and passing clouds headed to the Northward At 4 p^m wore ship headed S^W by W Through the night the same Latter part had some rain squalls and fine breeze headed S^W hands employed in ship duty so ends.

This day commences with light breeze from W^NW and good weather under of all sails headed S^W At sun down furled the light sails Through the night the same Latter part fine breeze and good weather headed the same hands employed in ship duty so ends.

This day commences with fine breeze from N^W and good weather steered S^E by S At sun down furled the light sails Through the night light air and calm At day light wind hauled to E and squally headed N^E by N so ends with strong breeze

This twenty four hours commences with strong Easterly wind and squally weather headed N^E by N under of short sails Through the night headed N^N & Latter part more moderate set the sails hands employed in ship duty so ends.
