This twenty four hours commences with fresh breeze from Eastward and passing clouds headed N by E 1/2 E At sun down short in sails Through the night the same Latter part light breeze under of all sails headed N so ends.

This day commences with light breeze from E N E and fair weather headed N under of all sails At sun down short in sails Through the night moderate Latter part light breeze headed to N E employed in making new roiel shrouds for main so ends

This day commences with light breeze from E S E steered N N W at 4 p m huf to headed N E by N At sun down wore ship headed S S E Middle and Latter part headed S E 1/2 S under of all sails hands employed in ship duty so ends

Wednesday Aug 25th
This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from E N E and good weather headed S E under of all sails Middle and Latter part wind N E headed E S E hands employed in ship duty rose new reef tables on fore top sail so ends

This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from N E and good weather headed S S E under of all sails Through the night squally headed E Latter part light winds from E N E back ship headed N hands employed in ship duty so ends

Friday Aug 27th
This twenty four hours commences with light breeze from S E and calm weather headed N by W At 5 p m wind hauled to the Northward back ship headed E S E under of all sails Middle and Latter part light air and calm hands employed in ship duty so ends
