

Remarks on board of Brig

Thursday Sept 16th

This twenty four hours commences with fine breeze from Eastward and fair weather they headed S S E through the night short in sails - had strong breeze headed S latter part the same so ends no obs sun obscured.

Friday Sept 17th

First part this twenty four hours strong breeze from E S E and cloudy weather headed S at 4 p m tack ship headed S E through the night the same latter part squall headed E S E at 8 A m saw Tayal bears E by S so ends

Lat 38°40 Long 27°37

Saturday Sept 18th

This twenty four hours commences with fresh breeze from S E and squally weather headed E S E through the night and latter part rainy and squally headed E by S so ends no obs.

Sunday Sept 19th

This twenty four hours commences with fresh gale from S S E headed to the Eastward had it squally furled the fore sail and reefed main stay sail Middle and latter part light winds and cloudy at 8 A m took up out of the sails and set the fore sail Barometer still down 29°62 lowest seen

Monday Sept 20th

This twenty four hours commences with light wind from S S E and cloudy weather Steered S W by S at 4 p m wind hauled I wore ship headed E S E sun down double reef the top sail and furled the foresail through the night wind increase and hauled to the Southwest headed S latter part strong gale from W S W and squally headed S W by W so ends.

Lat 39°53 Long 28°28 Bar 29°25

Tuesday Sept 21st

This twenty four hours commences with strong gale from W S W and squally weather headed S W under of short sails through the night the same latter part squally wind hauled to the Northward headed W at 9 A m saw Graciosa and St George so ends no obs. Barometer 28°92/100

Wednesday Sept 22nd

Commences with fresh gale from W S W and squally weather Steered for Graciosa at 4 p m luf to, to the leeward of the Island headed S W at 10 p m wore ship headed to the Northward through the night the same latter part fresh gale and squally at 10 A m keep her off for St Miguel At noon Terceira bears S 1/2 E Dist 12 miles so ends no obs
