Monday Oct 11th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze and cloudy weather headed to ESE at 4 p m tack ship headed NW by N Through the night the same Latter part headed for the land so ends.

Tuesday Oct 12th

This twenty four hours commence with fresh breeze from NNE and squally weather cruising to the Northward of San Miguel At 5 p m keep her off for the town At midnight put to Al N At m boat went ashore after Capt so ends.

Wednesday Oct 13th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from Northward At 2 p m boat come on board with three of the runaway men Frank Abancel and Jiminy At four oclock lunch come long side after shocks and shook heads, send them shore Middle part moderate Latter part fine breeze break out for provision at noon Capt came on board set the sails and steered I so ends

Thursday Oct 14th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from Northward and good weather steered I saw the Island of San Mary Middle and Latter part the same stowed the anchors and cable and a boy stowed away on board from shore his name so ends.

Lat 30° 24 Long 24° 06.

Friday Oct 15th

This twenty four hours commence with fine breeze from NNE and passing clouds steered I Employed in setting up the fly jib stay and main top mast back stay. Middle and Latter part wind more moderate Employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 34° 40 Long 23° 20

Saturday Oct 16th

This twenty four hours commence with light breeze from NE and cloudy weather Steered I Middle and Latter part the same hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 33° 29 Long 23° 00

Sunday Oct 17th

This twenty four hours light breeze from Westward and passing clouds with rain squalls steered I by E so ends

Lat 32° 27 Long 22° 16
