

Remarks on board of Brig

Tuesday Oct 26th

First and Middle part this twenty four hours fine N & trades and fair weather steered S W $\frac{1}{2}$ S Latter part strong trades steered S W by W At 9 A m saw the Island of Boa Vista bears W N W Dist 30 miles so ends.

Lat 15°49 Long 22°40

Wednesday Oct 27th

First part this twenty four hours fine N & trades and fair weather steered S $\frac{1}{2}$ E through the night moderate Latter part good breeze and passing clouds employed in ship duty so ends.

Lat 14°07 Long 21°15

Thursday Oct 28th

This twenty four hours commence with light N & trades and fair weather steered S $\frac{1}{2}$ E through the night the same At 8 a m had heavy squall from Eastward At 10 lowered for blackfish got none so ends.

Lat 12°50 Long 21°00

Friday Oct 29th

All this twenty four hours light trades and fair weather steered S $\frac{1}{2}$ E employed in ship duty and repaired the fly jib stay and set it up so ends

Lat 12°02 Long 20°30

Saturday Oct 30th

All this twenty four hours light N & trades and calm steered S by E hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 11°20 Long 20°16

Sunday Oct 31st

This twenty four hours commence with light N & trades and fine weather steered S by E caught a porpoise and lowered for blackfish but got none Through the night steered S by W At 6 A m saw blackfish lowered the boats L Bon got two and J Burt got two Employed in working on blubber so ends

Lat 10°37 Long 19°57

Monday Nov 1st

This twenty four hours commence with light trades and fair weather steered S by W employed in learning the blubber Through the night weather the same Latter part mended the blubber so ends

Lat 9°45 Long 19°54

Tuesday Nov 2nd

First and Middle part this twenty four hours light trades and fair weather steered S by W At 6 a m commence to boil the blubber At 7 lowered for blackfish each boat got one At 10 finish boiling so ends.
