First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from S E and cloudy weather headed S W At 4 p m commence to rain Middle and Latter part light breeze and squally weather under of all sails so ends

Friday Nov 12th
All this twenty four hours light breeze rain squalls and cloudy weather headed to the Southward under of all sails hands employed in ship duty saw black fish so ends

Lat 3 56 Long 19 43

Saturday Nov 13th
First part this twenty four hours fine breeze from Southward and cloudy weather headed to S W Middle and Latter part light breeze and rain squalls headed S S W so ends

Lat 2 56 Long 20 30

Sunday Nov 14th
This twenty four hours commence with light breeze from S S E and squally weather headed S W Through the night and Latter part strong breeze headed S W by W so ends

Monday Nov 15th
First and Middle part this twenty four hours fine breeze from S S E and passing clouds headed S W Latter part more moderate hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 00 47 S Long 23 25

Tuesday Nov 16th
All this twenty four hours fine breeze from S S E and fair weather headed S W Employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 03 24 S Long 24 50

Wednesday Nov 17th
All this twenty four hours fine breeze from S E and fine weather steered S S W hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 5 56 Long 26 04

Thursday Nov 18th
First and Middle part this twenty four hours fine S E trades and good weather steered S W by S 1/2 S Latter part wind more moderate saw two sails bound to the Southward hands employed in ship duty so ends

Lat 8 32 S Long 26 36

Bound to the Southward
